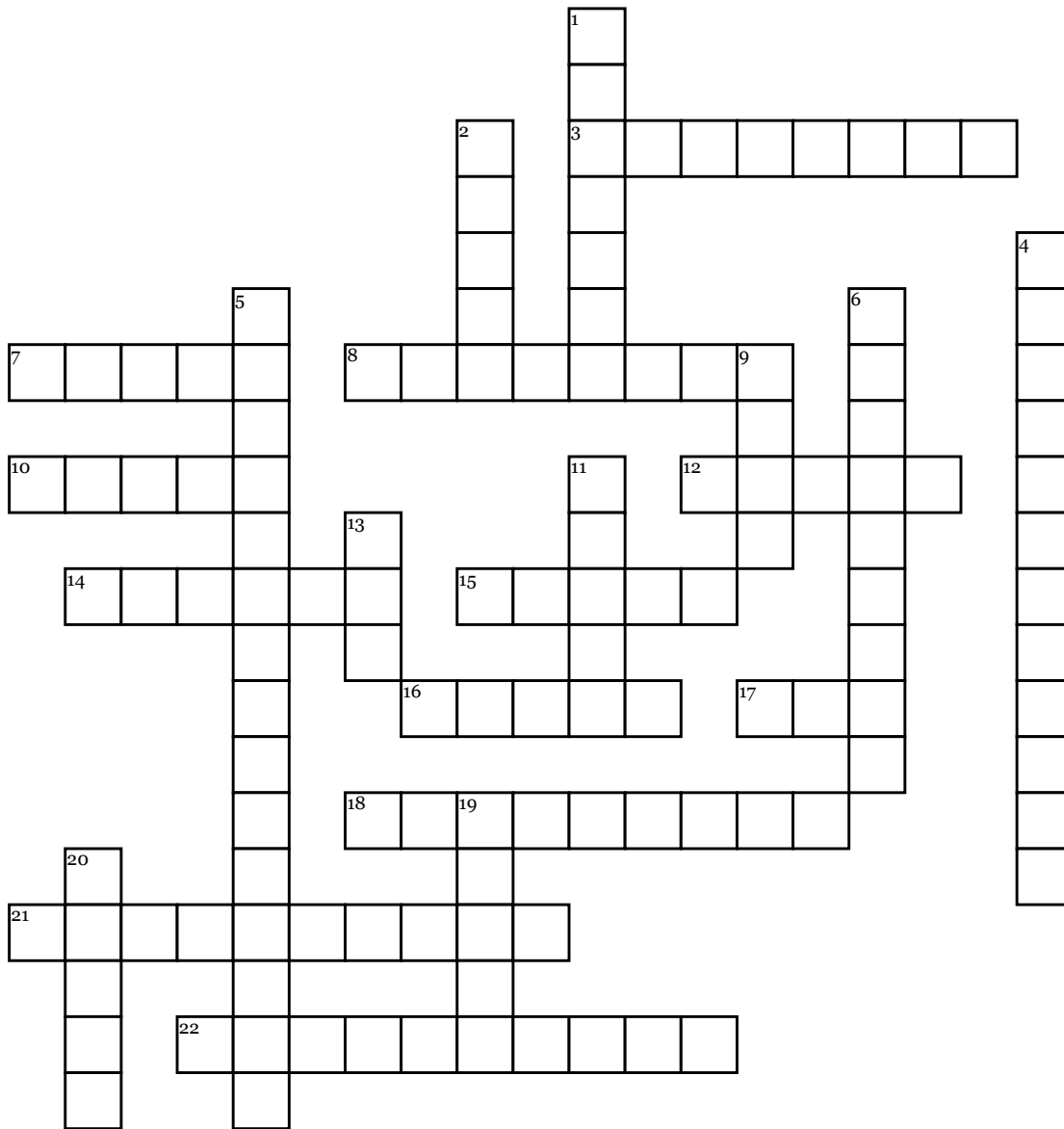


# Poetry Crossword Puzzle
