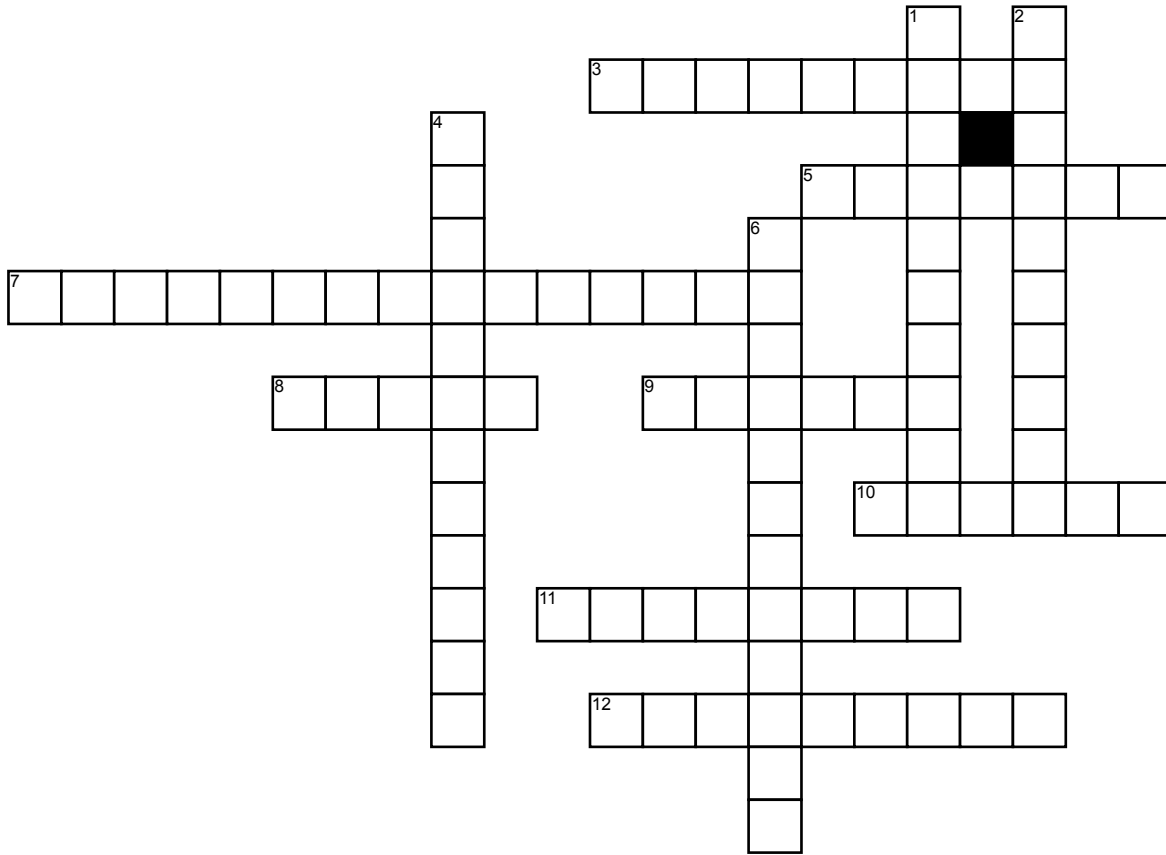


Poetry Devices Crossword

- 3. Repetition of internal vowel sounds. Doesn't have to rhyme! e.g Try to light the fire. Repetition of 'l' sound
- 5. Visually descriptive or figurative language that paints an image in the reader's head.
- 7. To give something inanimate human-like qualities

- 8. The recurrence of a pattern of stressed and unstressed syllables
- 9. A way of describing something through comparison using 'like' or 'as'
- 10. A grouping of two or more lines in a poem
- 11. Describing something figuratively as something else

- 12. A figure of speech involving extreme exaggeration
