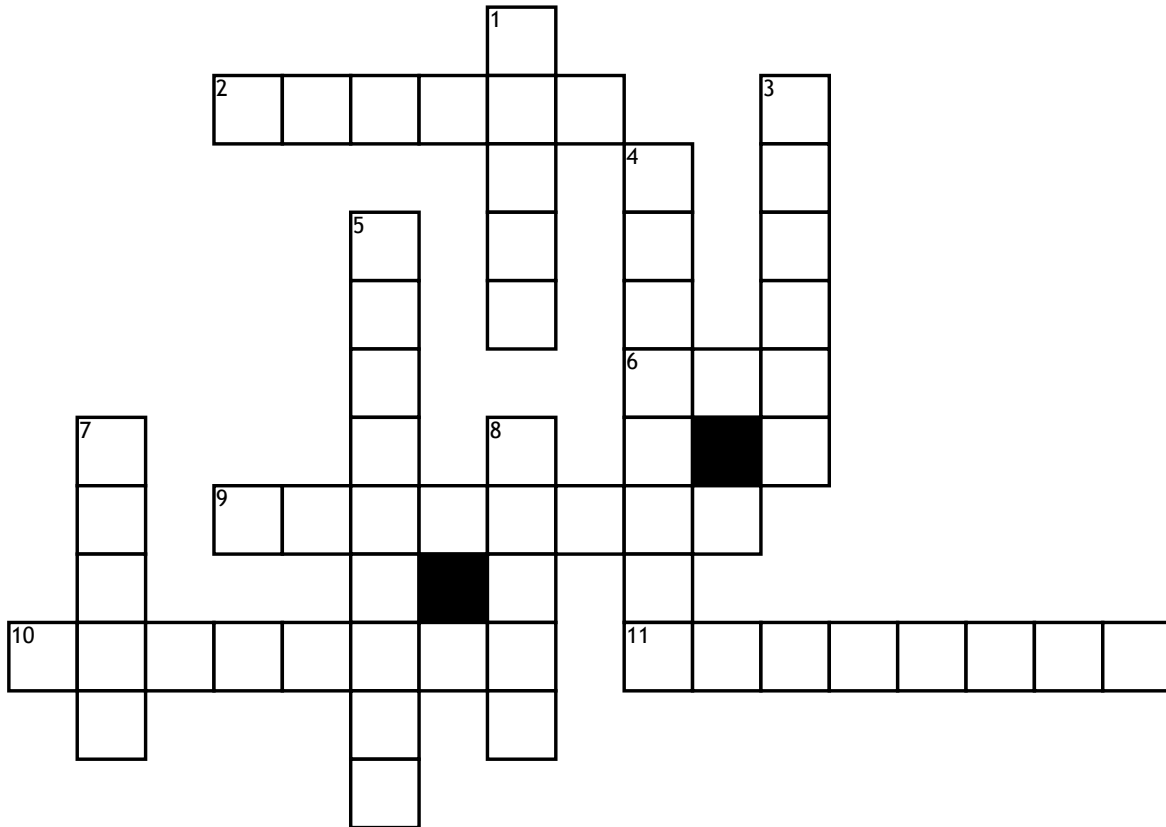


Poetry Types and Terms

- 2. a type of folk poetry associated with cattle ranching in North America
- 6. a form of lyric poetry that praises something or someone directly
- 9. makes the shape of a diamond; compares and contrasts two opposite things
- 10. a five-line, witty poem with a distinctive rhythm. The first, second and fifth lines, the longer lines, rhyme. The third and fourth shorter lines rhyme. (A-A-B-B-A).
- 11. the meaning or effect of words is shown visually; sometimes called visual poetry
