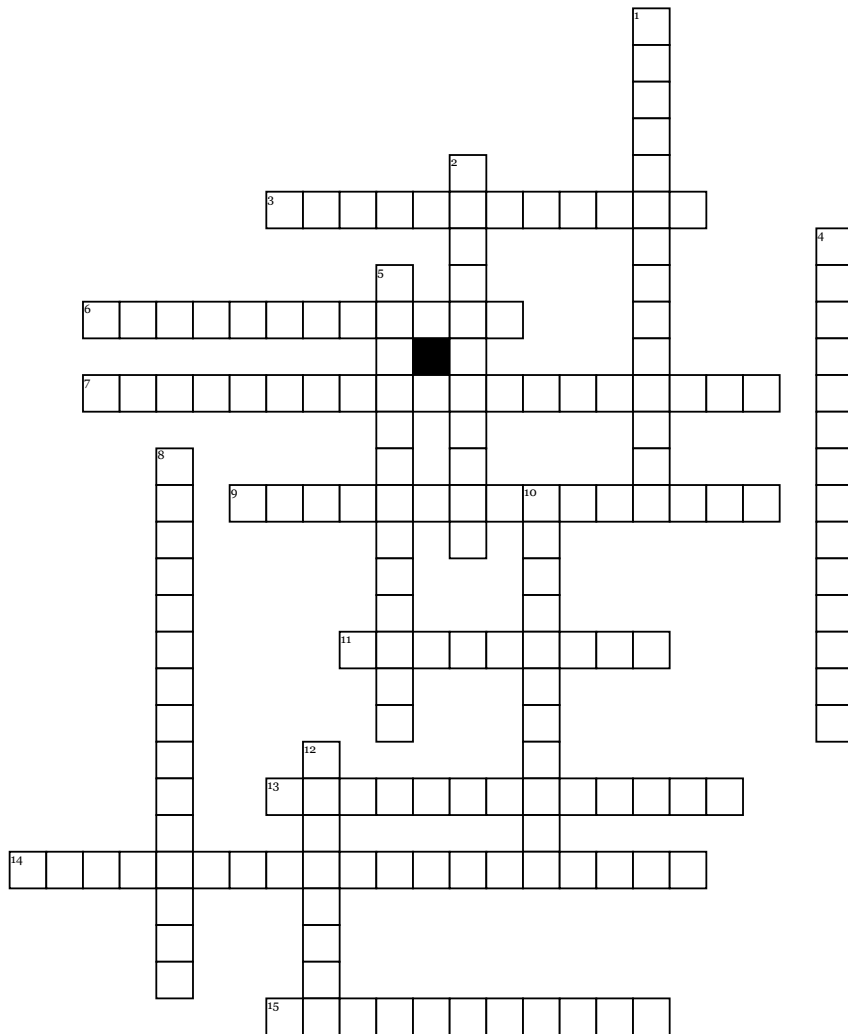


# Points of Interest
