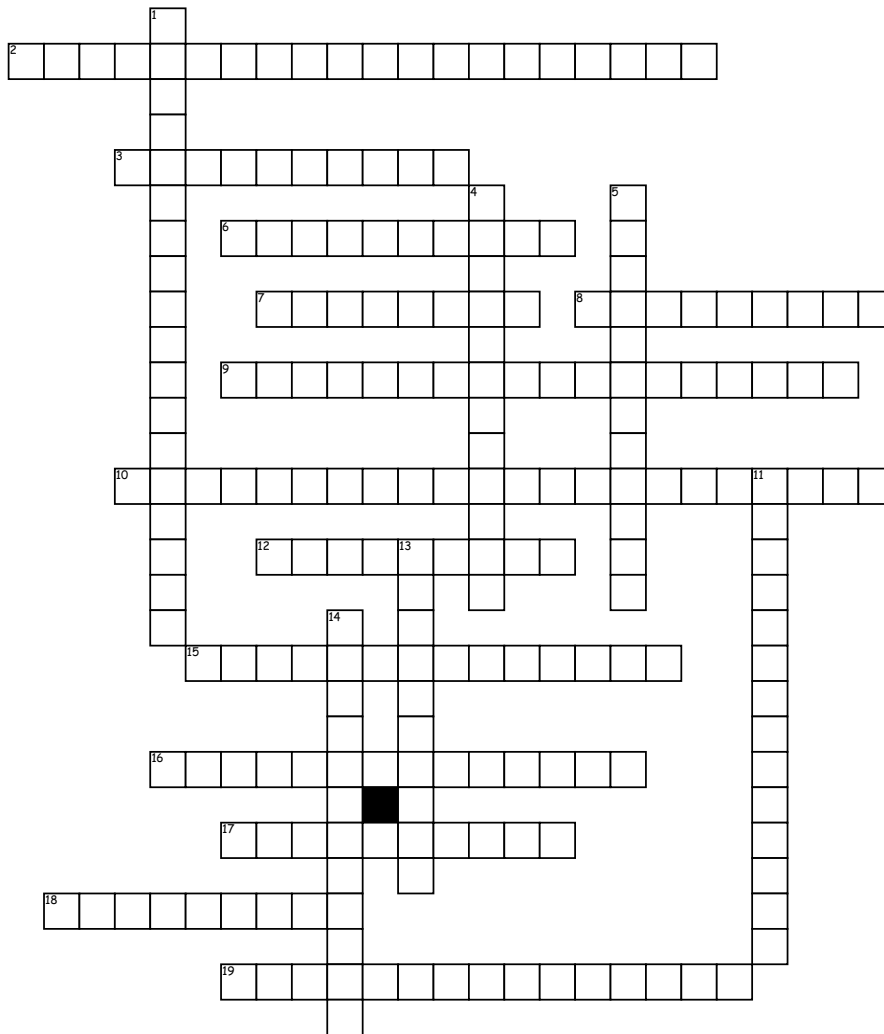


# Political Parties
