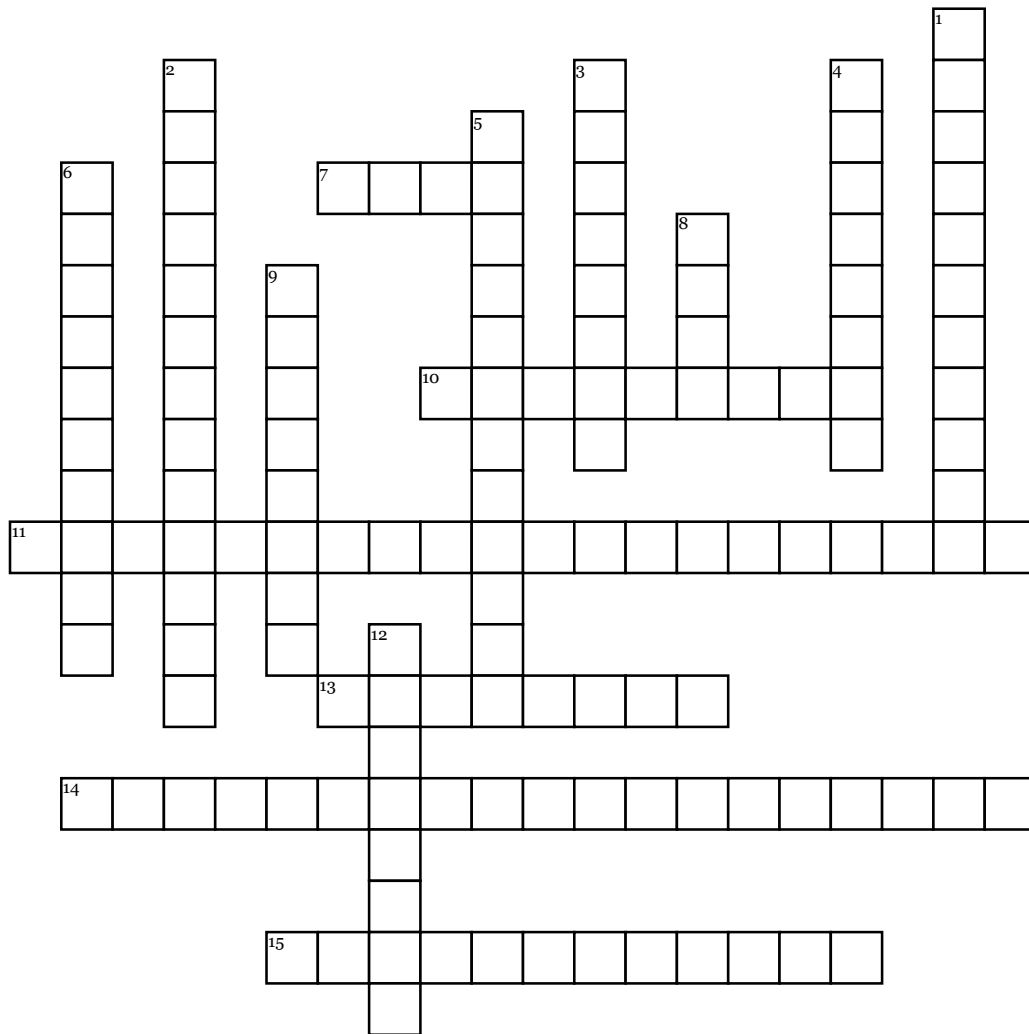


Polynomials Cross Word Puzzle
