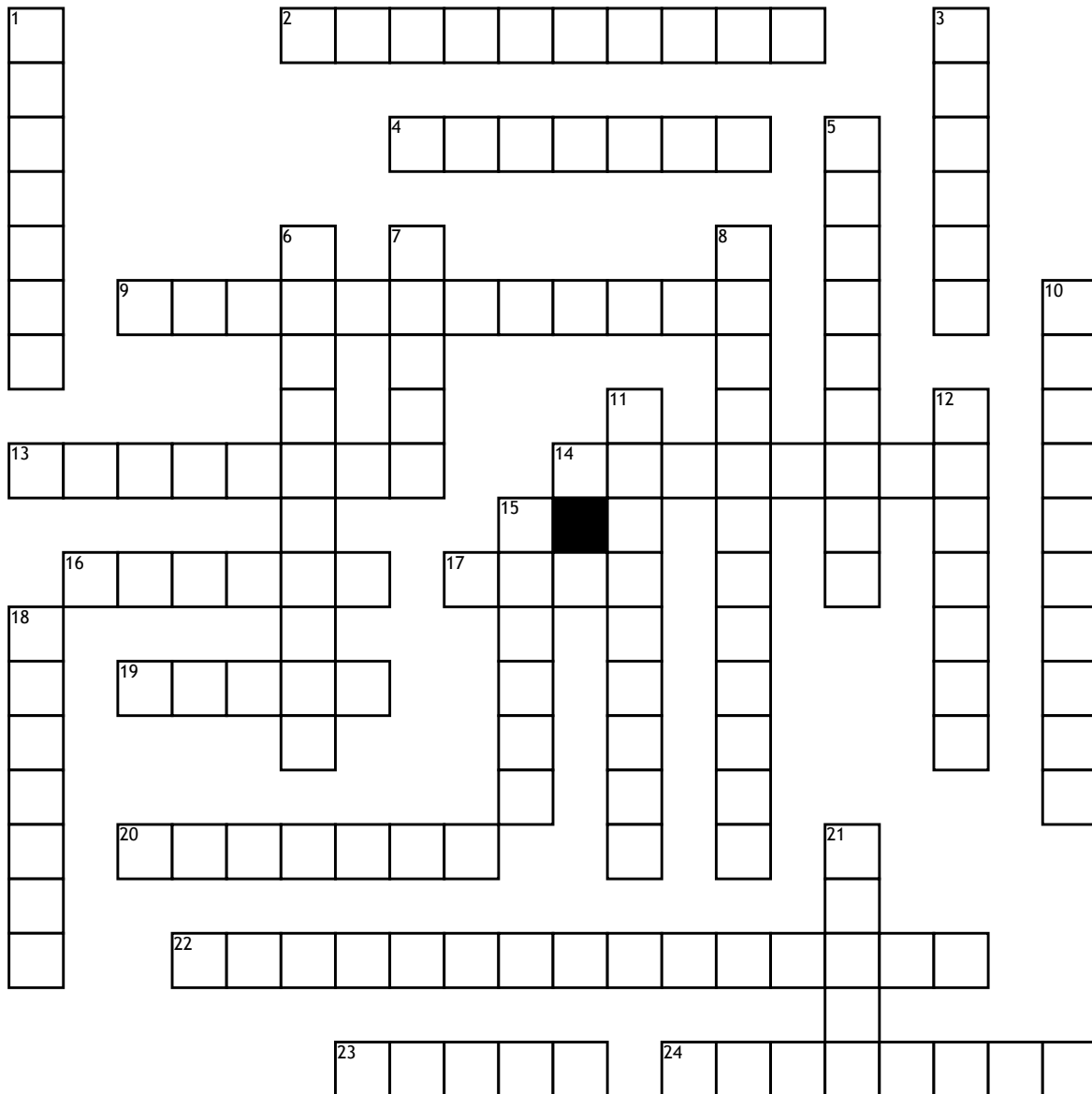


# Pompeii and Herculaneum

2. Square cut hole in the roof of a private house within the atrium to provide light, air, water.  
 4. Hot baths in a communal bath complex.  
 9. A shop that produces and serves hot food and drinks.  
 13. Large, covered meat and fish market in the Forum.  
 14. Justice building.  
 16. The subservient in a relationship who has a patron for protection and guidance.  
 17. A volcanic stone that is produced from the volcano.  
 19. Fish sauce.  
 20. Cleaning and production of cloth for clothing, laundry.

22. Volcanic debris and gas flowing at a fast pace similar to a snow avalanche.  
 23. Roman household.  
 24. Private shrine of household gods.

## Down

1. A bar, tavern, inn.  
 3. Atrium, Open space, central public space of Roman house and centre of religious and social activity.  
 5. The shallow pool which collected rain water under the compluvium.  
 6. Formal dining room in private homes containing three couches.  
 7. A public Roman space with buildings used for town gathering, official religion and trade.  
 8. An oval shaped building providing seating, entertainment venue.

10. Temple of Jupiter - dedicated to Jupiter, Minerva, Juno, state religion.  
 11. Public exercise ground for military and youth.  
 12. Roman family that lived in the household including the slaves  
 15. Volcanic rock due to the air content is light in weight.  
 18. Magistrates responsible for maintaining public buildings and spaces.  
 21. Terracotta pots in thermopolia contained drinks.
