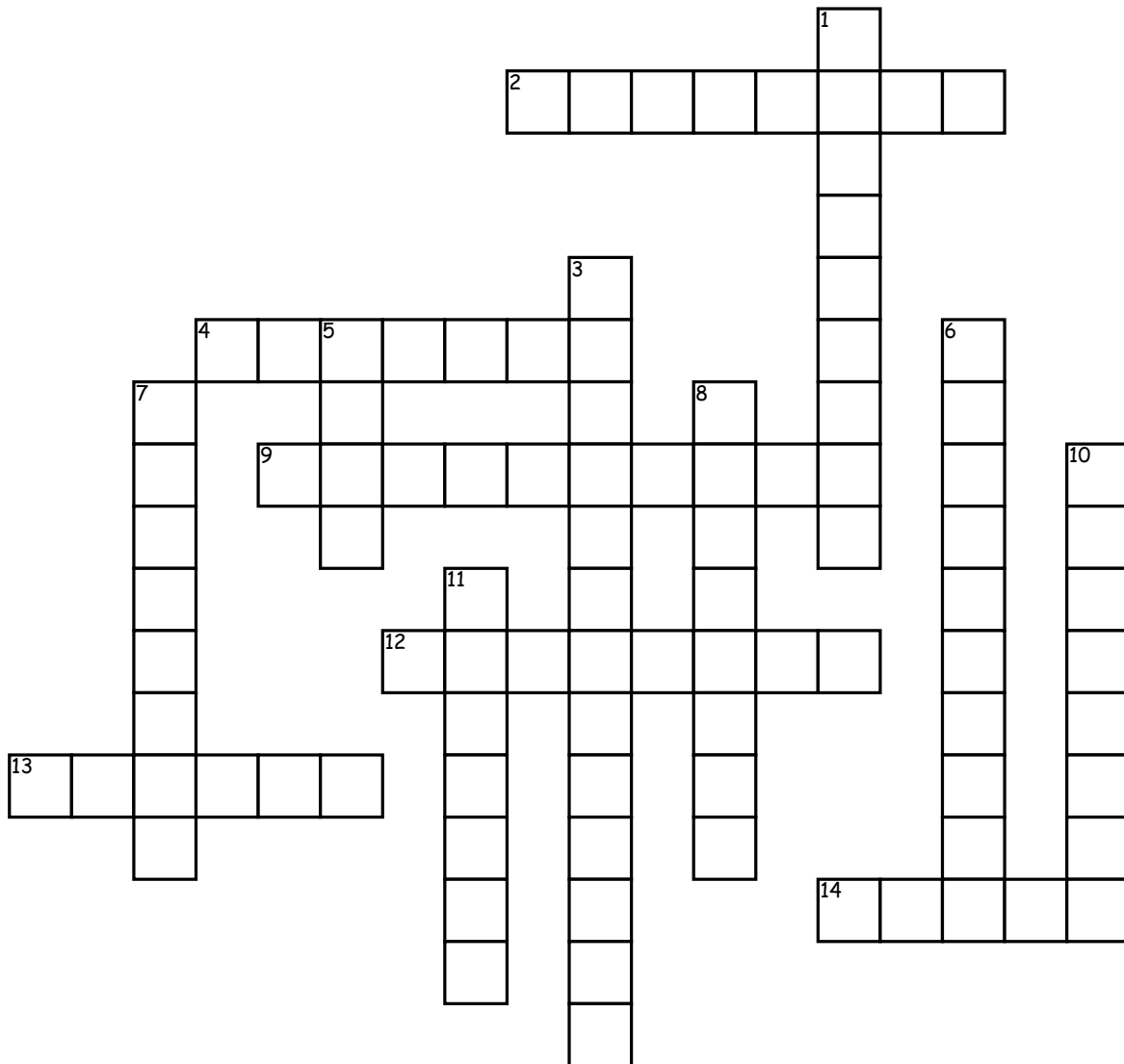


# Pope Francis Crossword Puzzle
