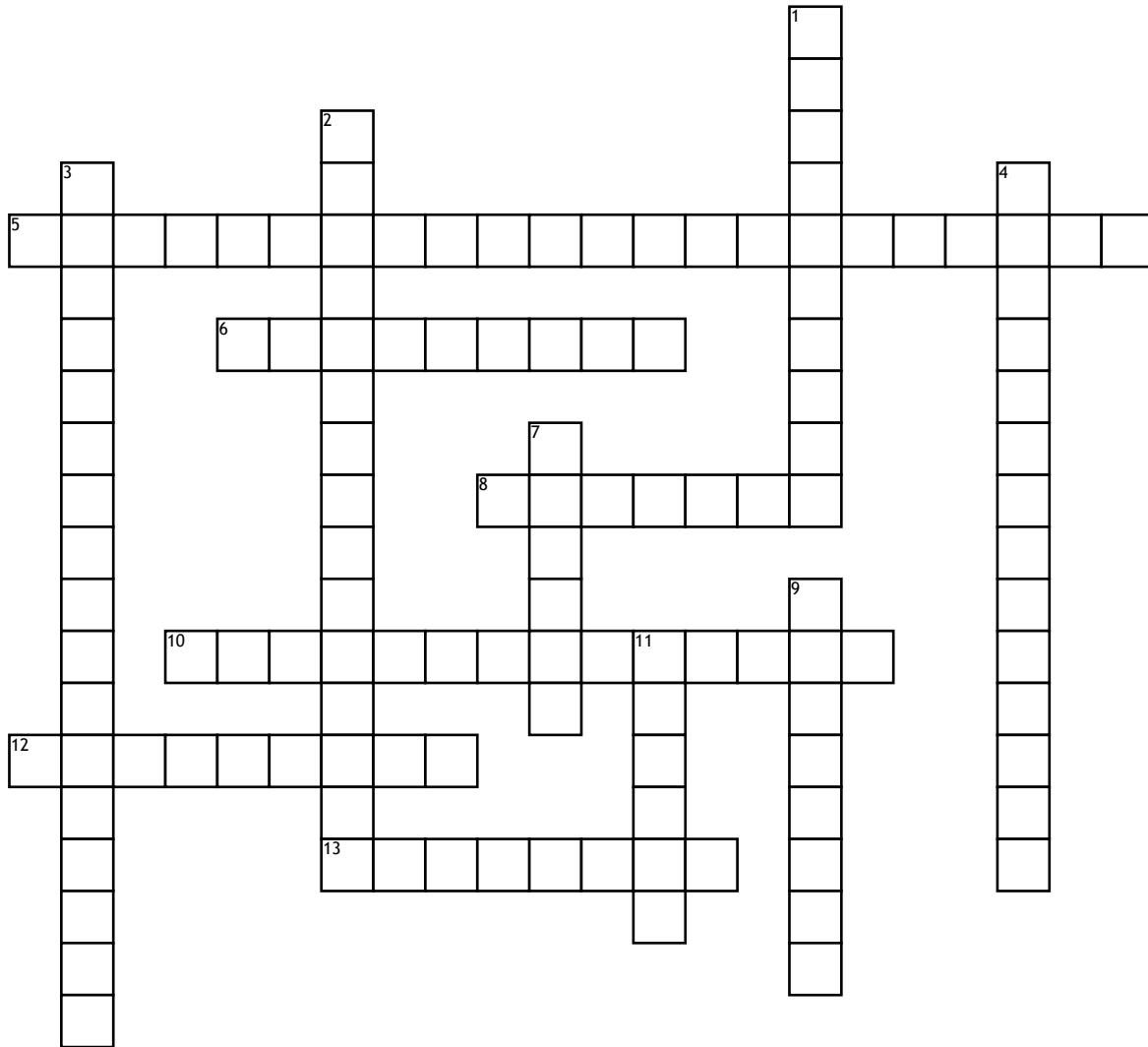


# Population and Migration
