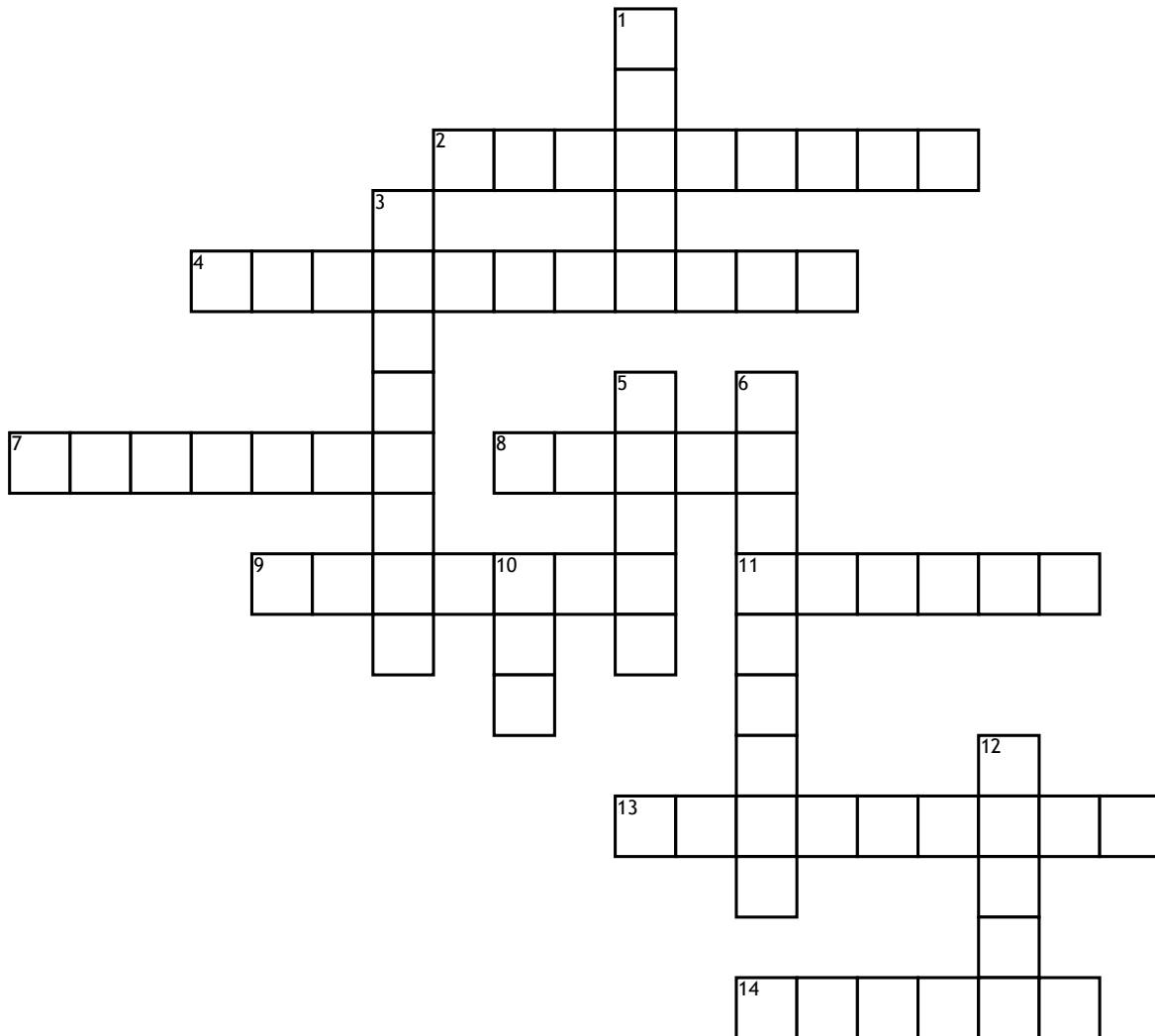


# Printmaking



## Across

2. A print pulled in an edition of one. The image usually painted on plexi-glass, and transferred on paper
4. The process of designing and producing prints using a printing block, woodcut, etching, lithograph or screen-printing
7. A printmaking technique where a drawing is scratched through wax-covered or tar covered metal plate which is then placed in acid that eats into the exposed areas making grooves in the metal

8. A round, smooth tool used to press paper against an inked linoleum block to transfer image to paper

9. A set of identical prints that are numbered and signed
11. Printmaking technique in which the image is printed from a raised surface, usually produced by cutting away non-image material
13. A metal or wooden plate with a raised edge on each end (opposite sides) to hold a linocut in place on the table while cutting
14. A roller with a handle

1. Also called a plate
3. Printmaking technique where ink is deposited below the surface of the plate, Examples are engraving and etching
5. The image made from printmaking process
6. When lines are cut into a metal plate with a v-shaped tool called a burin
