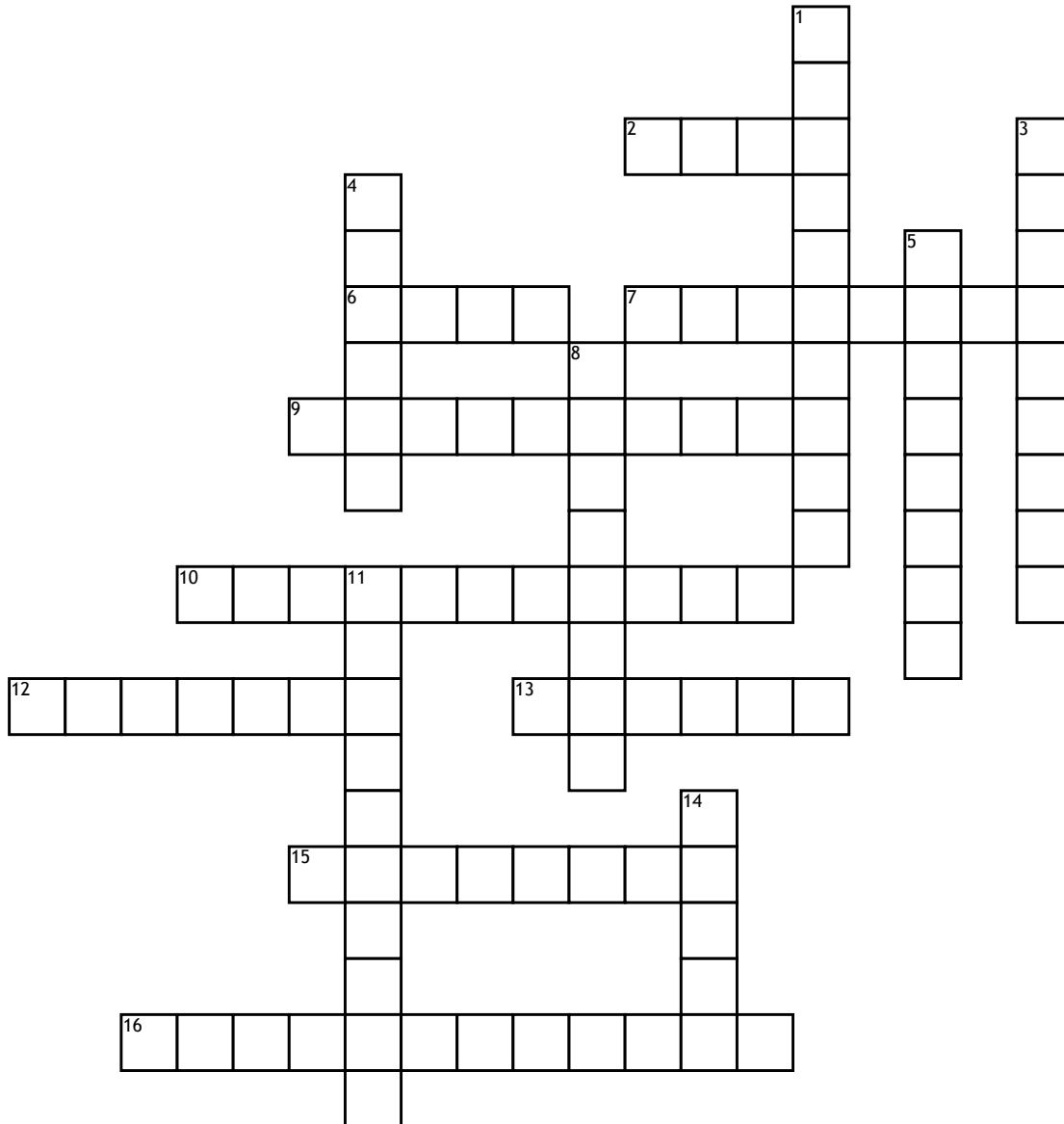


Privacy Puzzle
