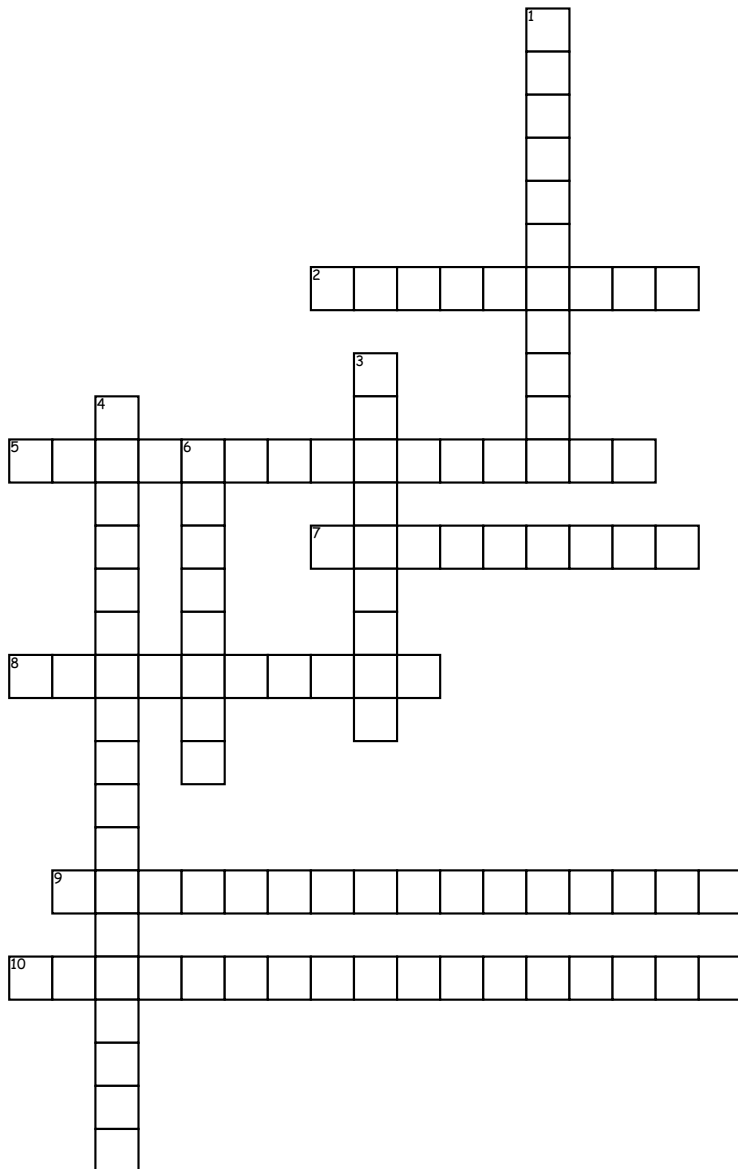


Progressive Era Vocabulary
