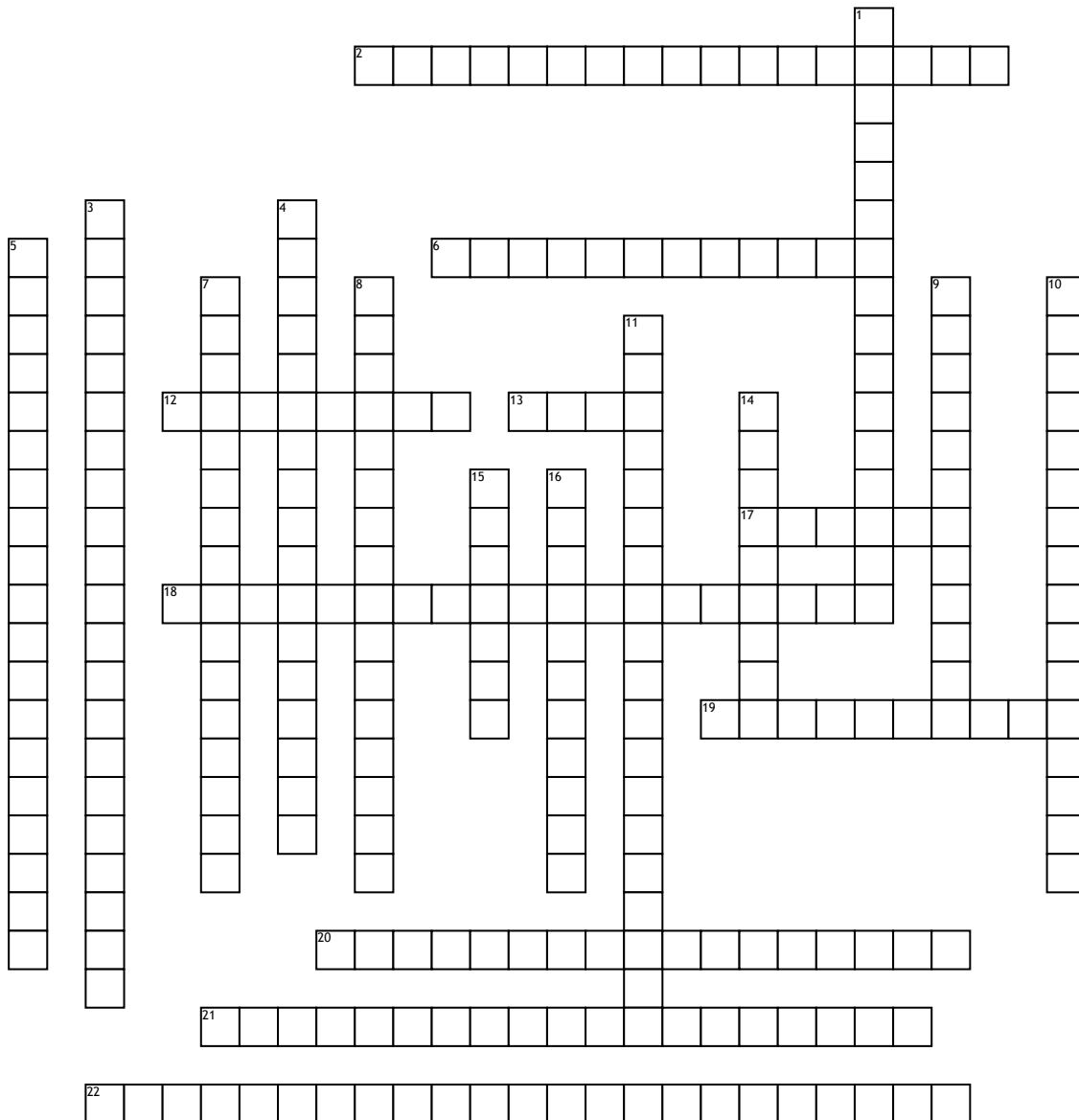

2. changes in independent variable cause changes in the dependent variable
 6. participants who do not receive the experimental treatment
 12. something that can be changed or varied
 13. prejudice in favor of or against one thing, person, or group
 17. moral responsibility to protect research participants from harm
 18. value of one variable increases as the value of the other decreases
 19. a mere assumption or guess
 20. data is gathered for the same subjects repeatedly over a period of time
 21. outcome and the exposures in the study participants at the same time

22. observing subjects in their natural environment

1. total group of individuals from which the sample might be drawn
 3. observing behavior of subjects that are in a controlled environment
 4. experiment that receives the variable being tested
 5. psychology experiment that is manipulated or changed
 7. drawn from a number of separate strata of the population
 8. participants nor the experimenters know who is receiving treatment
 9. selection of a sample unit is based on chance
 10. researchers don't tell participants if its test treatment or control treatment

11. steady relationship between two variables in the same direction

14. process or record of research of particular person, group, & situation
 15. substance with no known medical effects, such as sterile water
 16. measure of the extent to which two variables are related
