

Psychotropic Medications

1. Leading cause of vision loss in the U.S.
 2. Medication class used to treat anxiety
 3. Major side effect of a benzodiazepine (like Xanax or Valium)
 4. Class of drugs are used to treat depression
 5. Specific type of drug is the most commonly prescribed antidepressant
 6. Class of drugs are used to treat schizophrenia
 7. Example of a first generation typical antipsychotic drug
 8. A side effect of antipsychotic that causes various movement disorders
 9. Class of drugs used to treat Bipolar disease
 10. The drug that is mainstay in the treatment of bipolar disorders
 11. An irrational fear, resulting in a conscious avoidance of the feared object, activity, or situation
 12. Individuals with this disorder feel compelled to perform certain ritual acts, such as handwashing, over and over to relieve their anxiety
 13. Drug that can cause a psychological habituation and drug dependency or addiction
 14. Drug that has several dietary precautions - must avoid chocolate, caffeine, beer and red wines, and aged meat and cheeses
 15. A sudden onset of intense fear, although there is rarely any discernible cause
