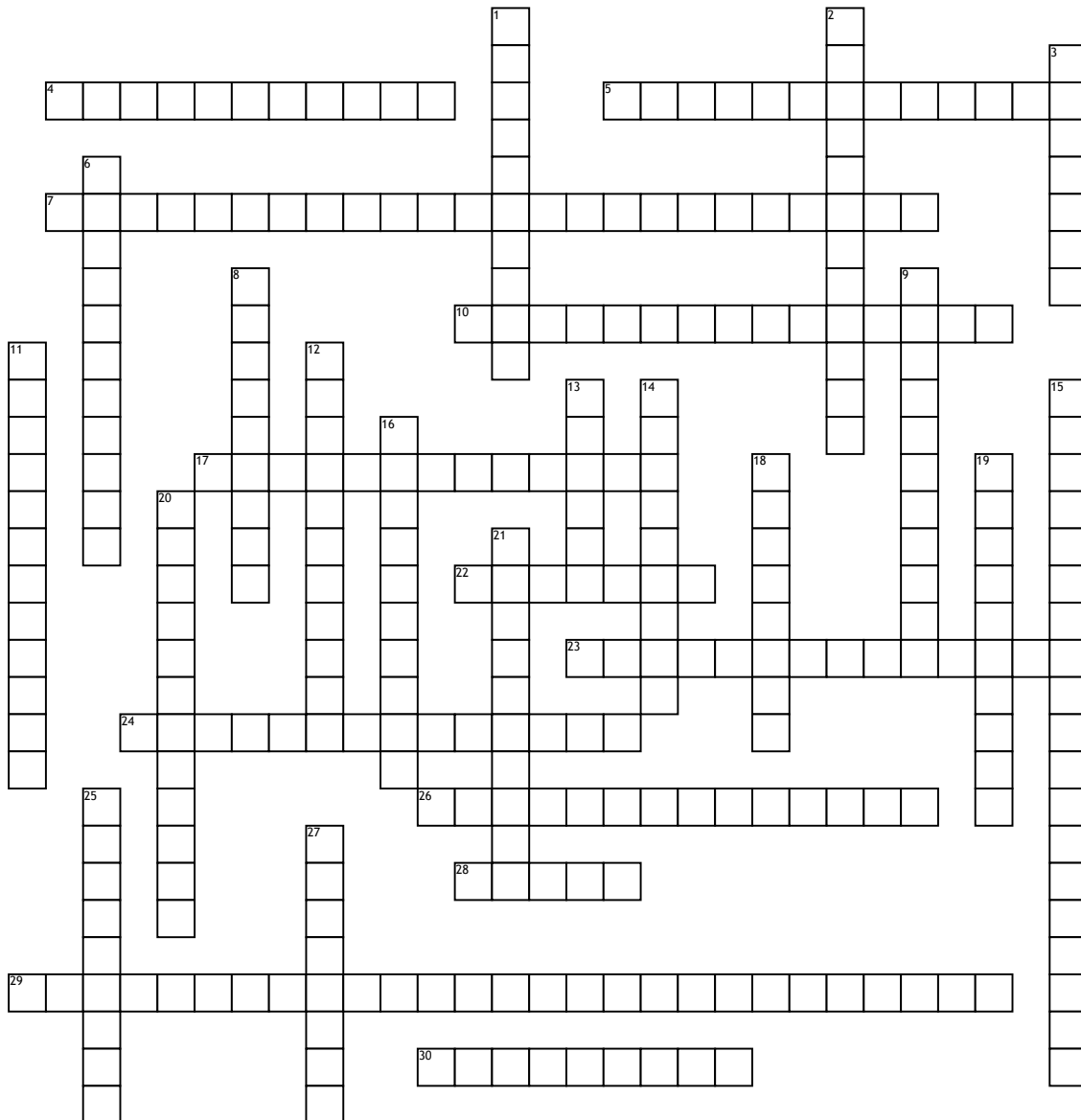


Purposes and Origins of Government

1. a rule or directive made and maintained by an authority
 2. lack of government intervention in free markets
 3. a state of society without government or law
 6. supreme and independent power in government claimed by a state

 9. the right of rule derives directly from God not from consent of people
 11. economic system combining private and public enterprise
 12. any familiar, long-established person, thing, or practice

13. large body of people associated with a particular territory

14. supreme power is vested in the people and exercised directly by them
 15. democratic society that owns and controls the economy
 16. prices and wages are determined by unrestricted competition
 18. supreme power rests in citizens voting for representatives of people
 19. free exchange between individuals and corporations
 20. a government in which absolute power is exercised by a dictator
 21. the political direction and control exercised over citizens of a state
 25. power is vested in a few persons or in a dominant class
 27. supreme power or sovereignty held by a single person
