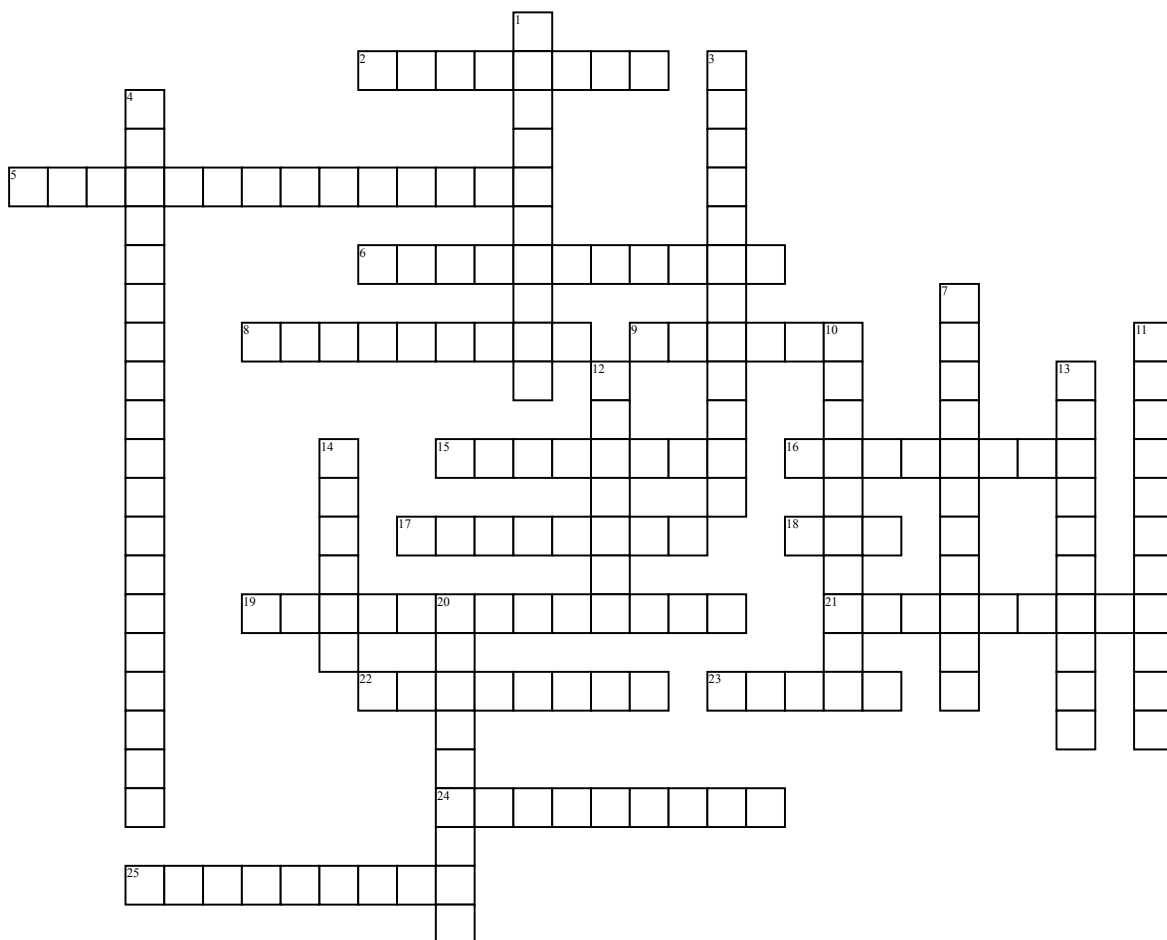


Qin Dynasty
