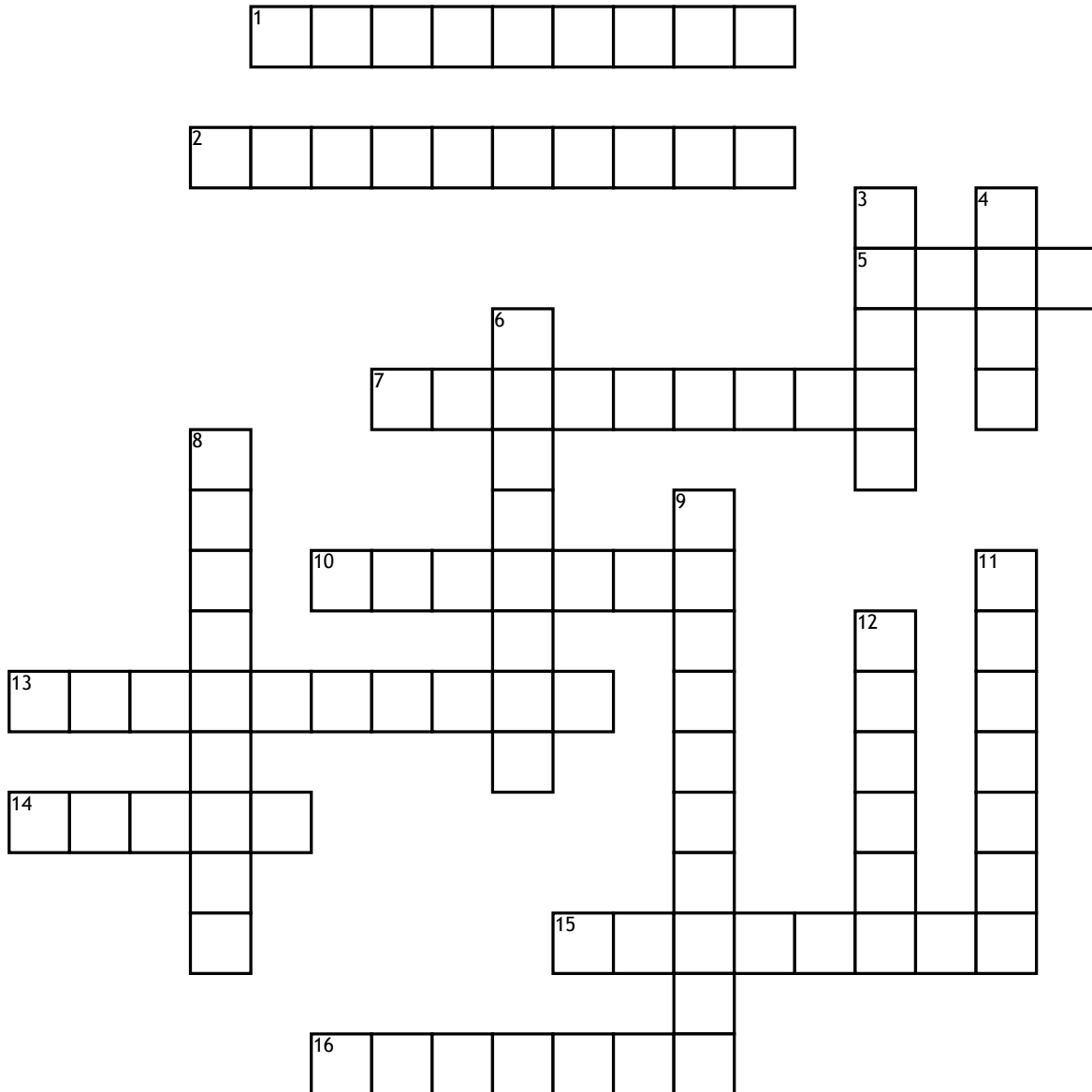


# Quarter 3 Vocabulary
