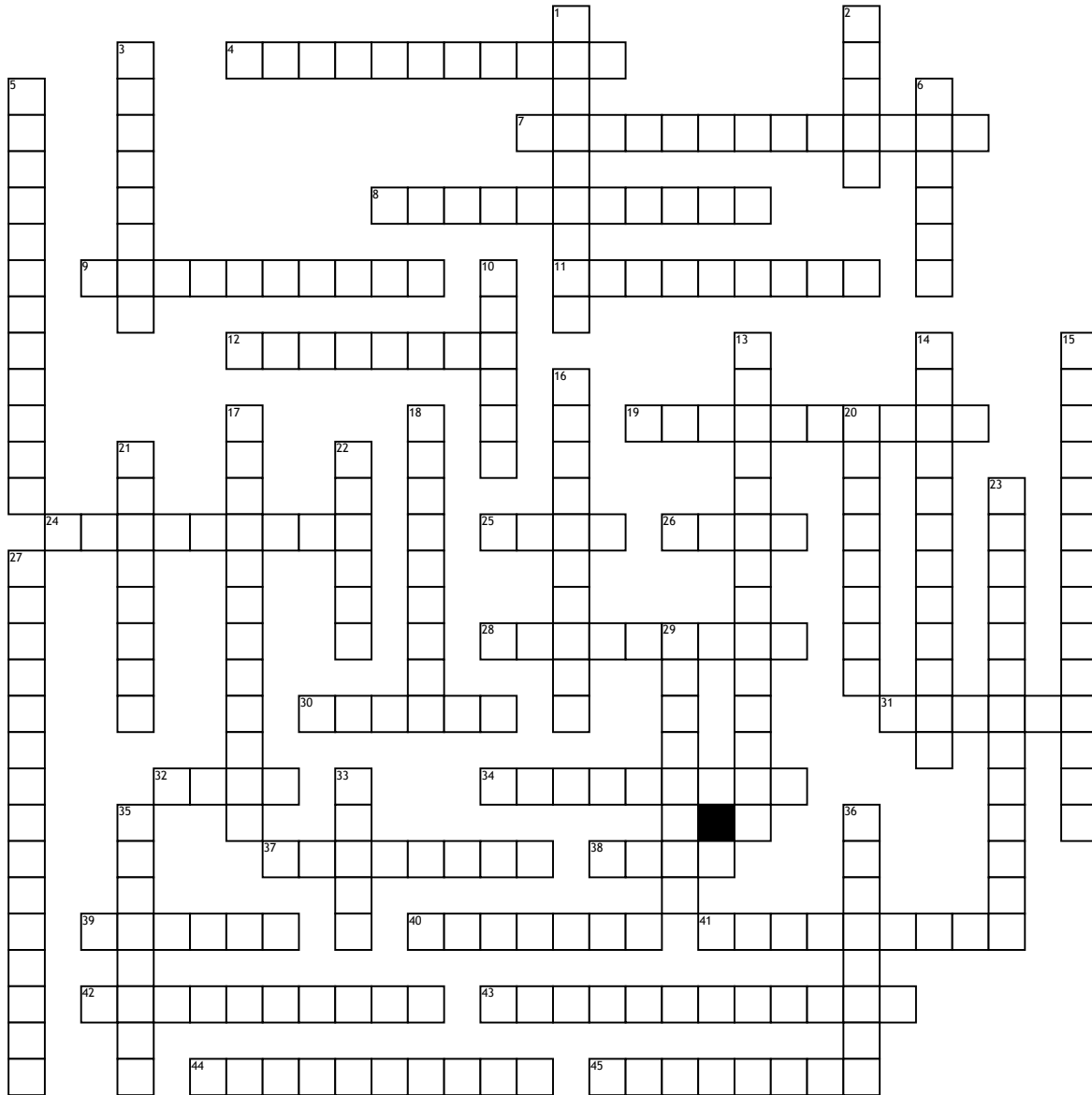

- 7. Doctor who diagnoses and treats diseases of the respiratory system
- 8. Obesity hypoventilation syndrome
- 9. An inflammation of the lining of your bronchial tubes
- 11. Condition of COPD
- 12. Condition in which the lungs become scarred over time
- 19. Disorder in which pauses in breathing or periods of shallow breathing occur during sleep
- 24. Relating to the lungs
- 25. A treatment that uses air pressure to keep your airways open while you sleep
- 26. Bronchiolitis obliterans organizing pneumonia, for short
- 28. Coal workers' pneumoconiosis (CWP)
- 30. An infection of the blood stream
- 31. Forms a ridge between the openings of the right and left principal bronchi
- 32. Group of progressive lung disorders characterized by increasing breathlessness
- 34. Infection of the air sacs in one or both the lungs
- 37. Chemicals, often hormones, that your body makes naturally
- 38. Organ for protection, regulation, and sensation

- 39. Breathe with a whistling or rattling sound in the chest
 - 40. Condition in which an orifice or passage in the body is abnormally closed or absent
 - 41. The passage of blood through the blood vessels in an organ or tissue
 - 42. Lung disease that develops due to inhalation of asbestos

- 1. A drug delivery device used to administer medication in the form of a mist inhaled into the lungs
 - 2. Primary organs of the respiratory system
 - 3. A rare autoimmune multisystem disease which causes inflammation of blood vessels
 - 5. Situated between the cells of a structure or part
 - 6. Condition in which the airways narrow and swell causing reversible obstruction
 - 10. Computerized tomography
 - 13. Disease caused by breathing in certain kinds of dust particles
 - 14. A collapsed lung that occurs when air enters the space around lungs
 - 15. A condition in which airways of the lungs remain persistently widened

- 16. A surface-active lipoprotein complex (phospholipoprotein) formed by type II alveolar cells
- 17. Performed using a flexible, lighted tube to examine the airways
- 18. Condition characterized by sideways curvature of the spine or back bone
- 20. Inflammation of the thin layer of tissue that lines the lungs and chest wall
- 21. Lung disease caused by prolonged exposure to talcum powder
- 22. Third-most abundant element in the universe by mass
- 23. Condition in which your heart's mitral valve doesn't close tightly, allowing blood to flow backward in your heart
- 27. Carries blood from the right ventricle to the lungs for oxygenation
- 29. Excessive inward curvature of the spine in the lower back.
- 33. Condition where fluid accumulates in lung tissues
- 35. Abnormality of the spine causing excessive curvature with pain and stiffness
- 36. Escape of fluid into a body cavity.
