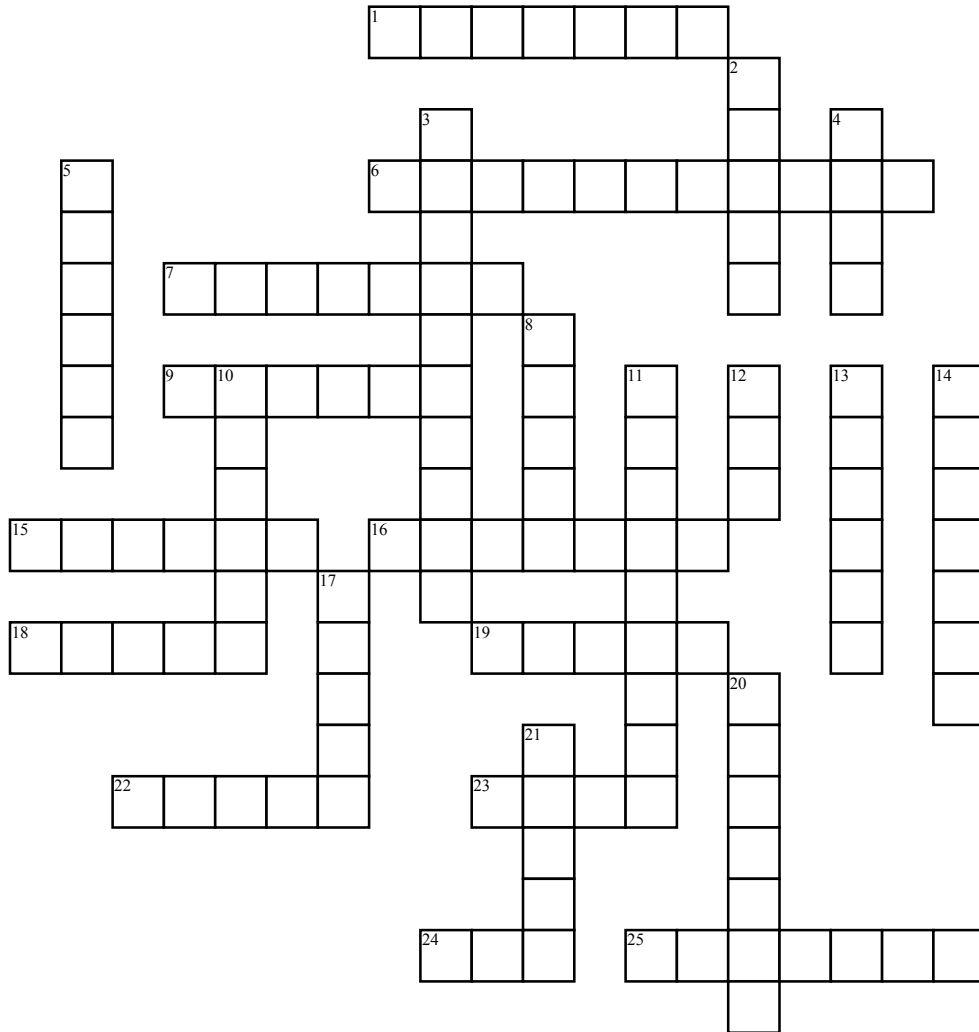


ROMAN Mythology

 16. female divinity of the sea, worshipped as the goddess of salt water who presided over the depths of the ocean
 18. God of the underworld
 19. virgin goddess of the hearth, home, and family
 22. Goddess of harvest and agriculture

23. the god of war and also an agricultural guardian, a combination characteristic of early Rome
 24. Wife of Cronos
 25. goddess of wisdom, war, art, schools, and commerce. She was the Etruscan counterpart to Greek Athena.

 8. goddess of flowers and of the season of spring – a symbol for nature and flowers

10. god of music, truth and prophecy, healing, the sun and light, plague, poetry, and more
 11. the woman who interfered with Hera's plan to hinder the birth of Heracles in favor of Eurystheus
 12. Roman goddess of peace, the equivalent of the Greek Eirene
 13. god of fire including the fire of volcanoes, metalworking, and the forge
 14. god of the grape harvest, winemaking and wine, of ritual madness, fertility, theatre and religious ecstasy
 17. Goddess of love, beauty, and pleasure
 20. God of the sea
 21. the daughters of Erebus and Nyx
