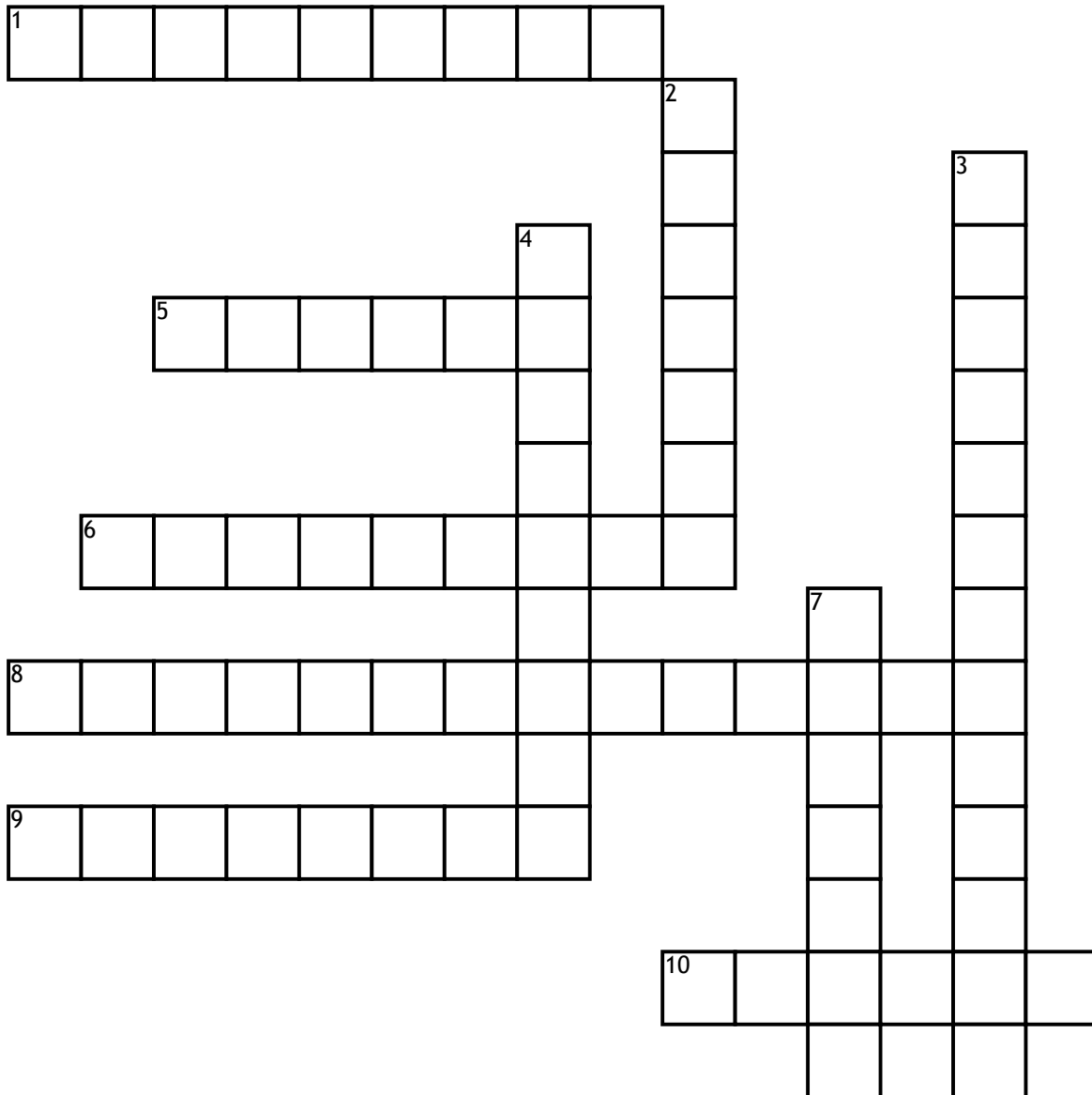


Race, Ethnicity and Language
