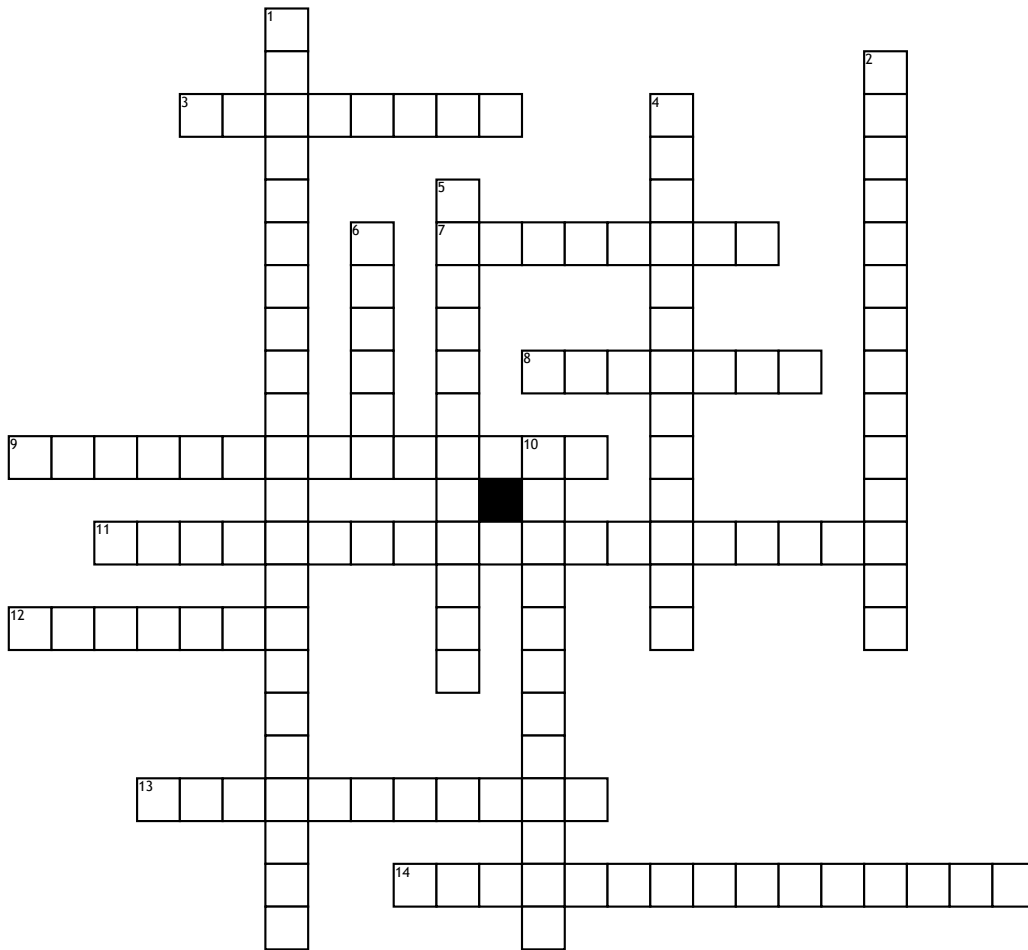


# Radiology Pathology



## Across

3. blood clot in the vascular system (chpt 7)  
 7. the study of neoplasms (chpt. 1)  
 8. encapsulated collection of pus (chpt. 1)  
 9. malignant tumor of the cartilaginous origin (chpt 4)  
 11. infection of the membranes covering the brain and spinal cord caused by bacteria (chpt 8)

12. any foreign matter, such as a blood clot or an air bubble, carried in the bloodstream (chpt 7)  
 13. dilation of the ureter (chpt 6)  
 14. bone marrow malignancy (chpt. 4)

## Down

1. refers to several conditions that have an alteration in intestinal motility (chpt 5)  
 2. chronic dilation of the bronchi or bronchioles (chpt.3)

4. abnormally positioned kidneys that may be found in various locations, from the true pelvis (pelvic kidney) to above the diaphragm (intrathoracic kidney) (chpt 6)

5. selective or disproportionate gaseous distention of the large bowel without an obstruction (chpt 5)

6. widespread narrowing of the airways as a result of exposure to stimuli (chpt. 3)

10. insulated by fatty covering (chpt 8)
