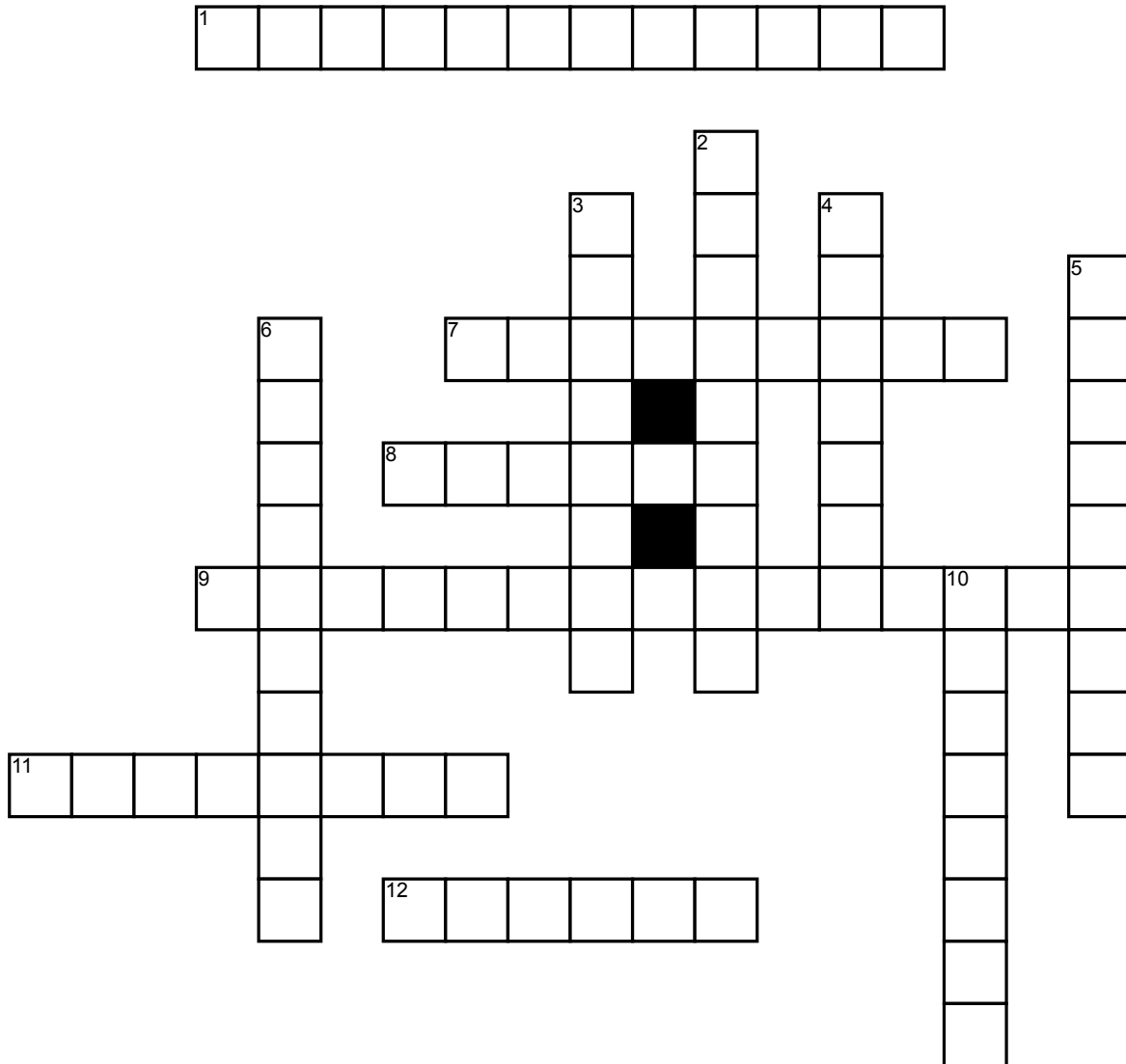

- 1. Exfoliative dermatitis affecting up to 90% of the skin
- 7. Chronic inflammatory skin condition, common in Caucasians
- 8. Dry and scaly, tends to affect children
- 9. Roughened skin with accentuated skin markings
- 11. Linked to auto-immune conditions, common in Indian population

- 12. Palpable scaling lesion

- 2. Change shape and may last a few minutes - hours
- 3. Medical term for hair loss, women typically present with this more than men
- 4. Chronic rash affecting the central face in people less than 60 years old, may eventually cause the development of a rhinophyma

- 5. Staphylococcal infection of adjacent hair follicles

- 6. acute superficial form of cellulitis and involves the dermis and upper subcutaneous tissue

- 10. Honey coloured lesions, usually staphylococcal in origin
