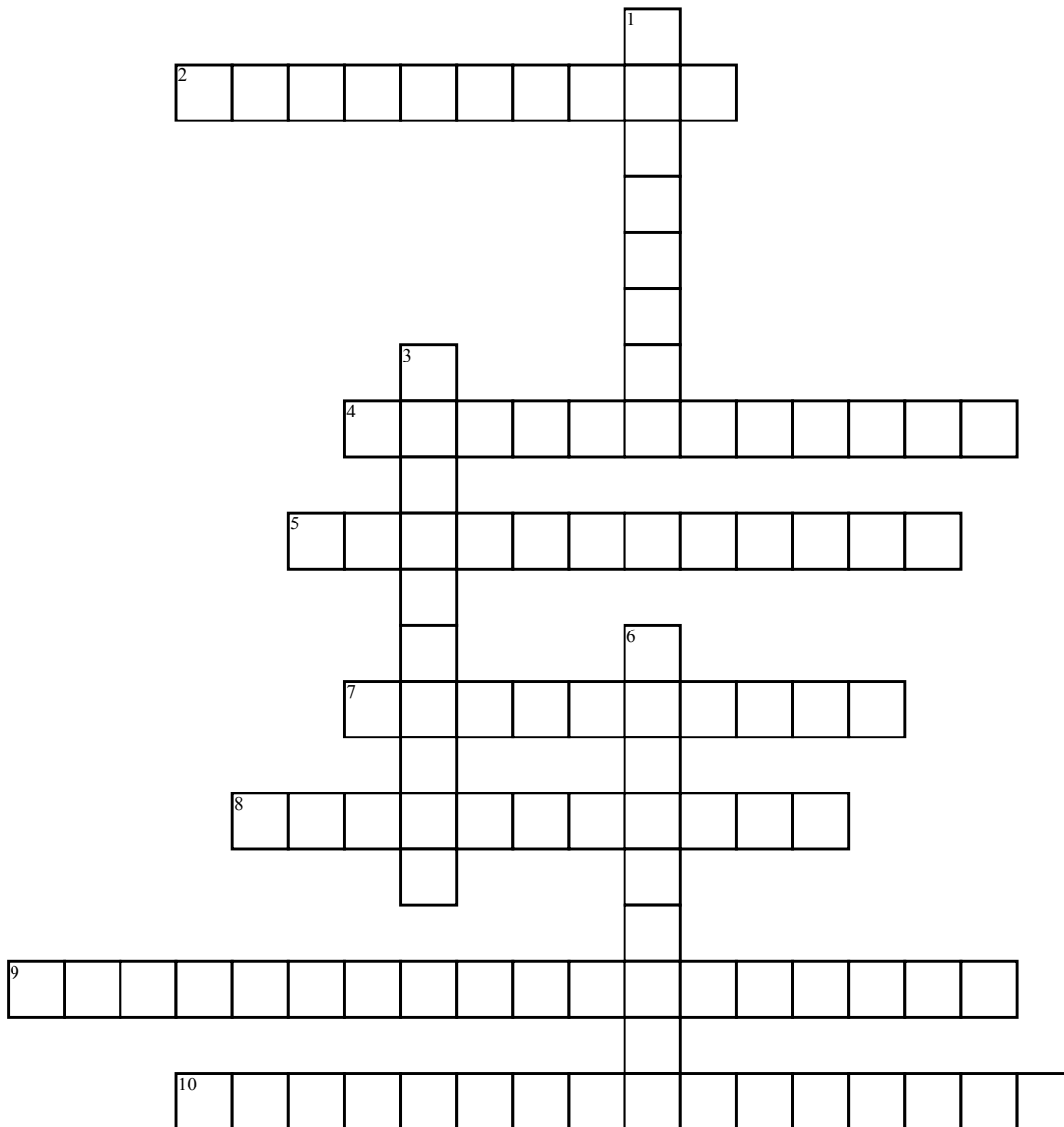


# Reconstruction Period

- 2.** Group of white supremacists that believe in white nationalism and anti immigration
- 4.** Area of public land in West granted to any U.S citizen willing to settle on and farm the land for at least five years.
- 5.** Person from the Northern states who went to the South after the Civil War to profit from Reconstruction
- 7.** Laws passed by Southern states restricting African Americans freedom
- 8.** State and local laws that enforced racial segregation in the Southern United States.

**9.** was the first United States federal law to define citizenship and affirm that all citizens are equally protected by the law.

**10.** An informal, unwritten deal that settled the intensely disputed 1876 U.S. presidential election.

- 1.** Authorized the President of the United States to survey American Indian tribal land and divide it into allotments for individual Indians.
- 3.** Act made it possible for western states to establish colleges for their citizens
