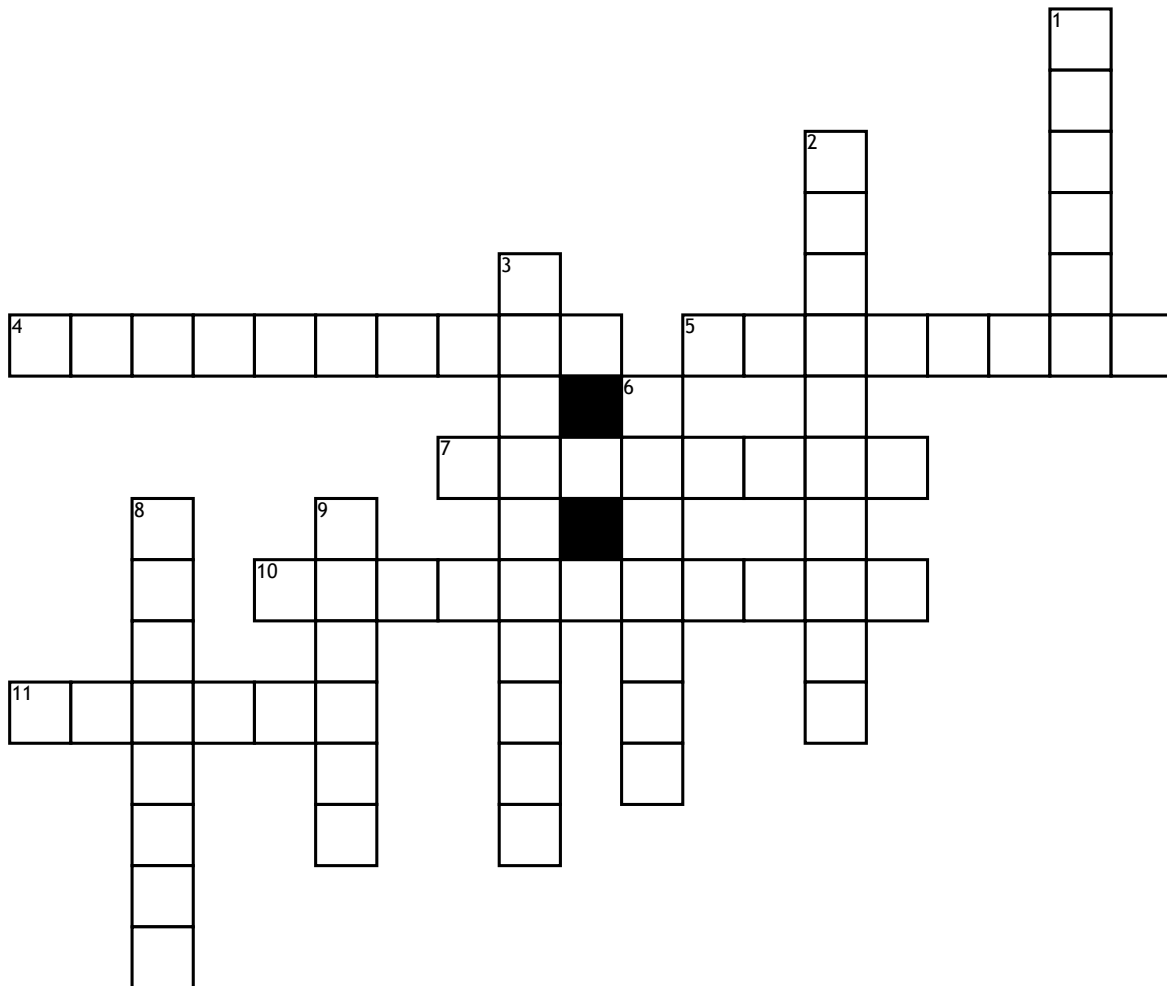

4. Anything added or removed to decrease a behavior
5. Any ITEM the child receives as a reinforcer
7. The child's response. Observable and objective.
10. Reinforcement, punishment, or a correction
11. A type of tangible reinforcer such as candy or juice

Down

1. Praise, physical play, smiling, clapping, nodding, hugs, high five, etc.
2. Something added or removed to increase likelihood of a behavior
3. Stimulus, instructional demand, prompt
6. Reinforcement that occurs spontaneously following a behavior. Ex: working in the garden, may produce food to eat
8. preferred games, computer time, OT room break.
9. Points/tallies/icons for appropriate behavior to earn a larger reinforcer.
