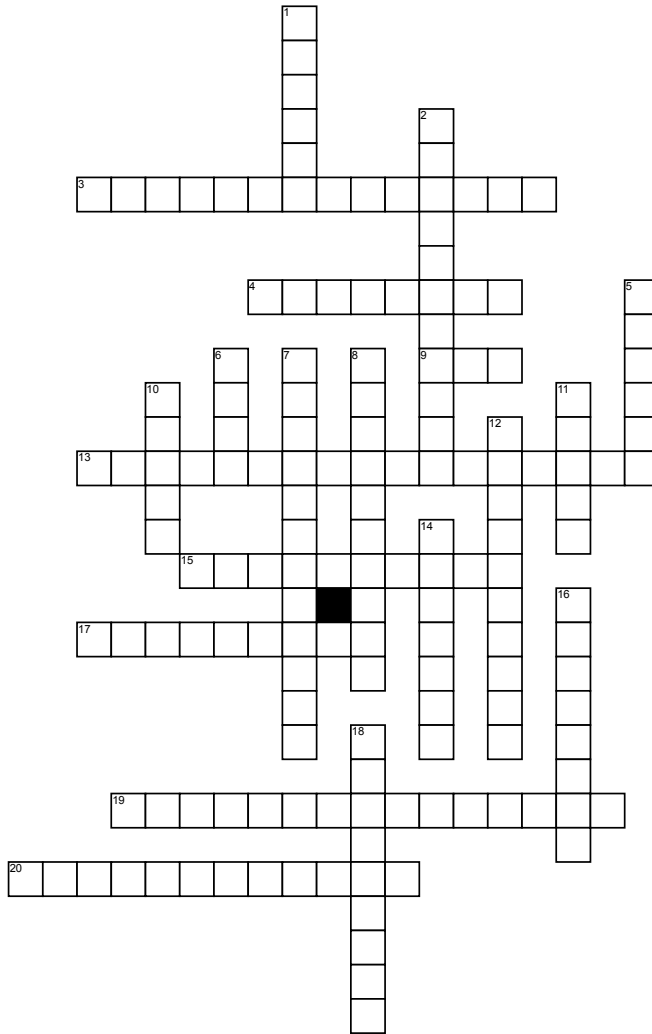

## Down

- 1.** This person leads mass  
**2.** Used to clean the chalice and Ciborium  
**5.** Vessels used to place water and wine  
**6.** Is used to hold the lectionary  
**7.** The touching of the right knee to the floor while bending the left knee

- 8.** A collection of liturgical readings

- 10.** A plate shaped vessel usually made of precious metal or gold  
**11.** Signifies Jesus' body present among us  
**12.** Used by the priest to begin the mass  
**14.** Means Jesus, God's anointed son and Savior  
**16.** Is placed over the altar stone  
**18.** Reminds us that Jesus is present in the tabernacle
