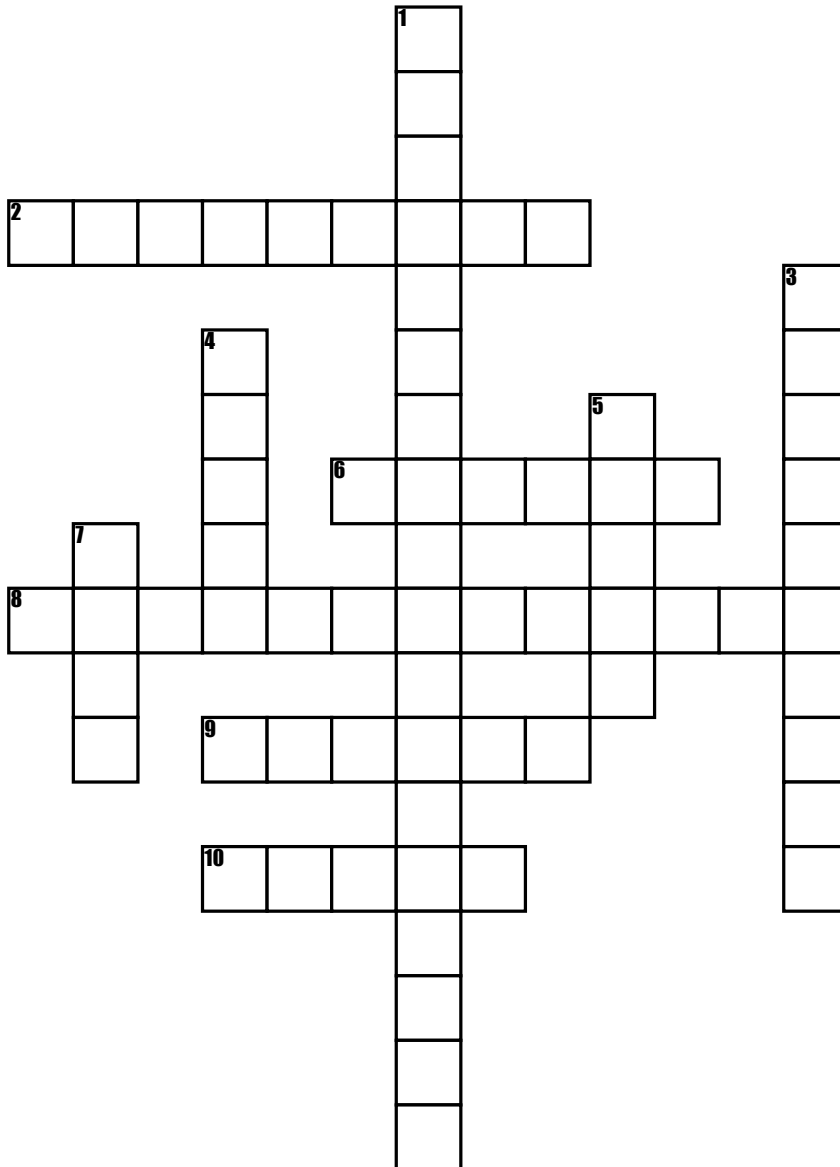


# Renaissance Fashion Crossword



## **Across**

- 2.** The clothes, household linen, and other belongings collected by a bride for her marriage.
- 6.** Short velvet or leather jacket, usually sleeveless (men)
- 8.** Large, wide, square-toed shoes often decorated with jewels or slashes (men)
- 9.** A woman's tightly fitting undergarment extending from below the chest to the hips, worn to shape the figure
- 10.** Metal drawn out into the form of a thin flexible thread or rod.

## **Down**

- 1.** sleeves where the outer fabric was slit horizontally and the sleeves of the undergarment were pulled through (women)
- 3.** Stuffing for trunk hose, peascod-belly, and leg-of-mutton sleeves, composed of rags, flock, and other materials
- 4.** An outdoor overgarment, typically sleeveless, that hangs loosely from the shoulders.
- 5.** (Of an area or space) Having or allowing little room for maneuver
- 7.** A projecting starched frill worn around the neck, characteristic of Elizabethan and Jacobean costume
