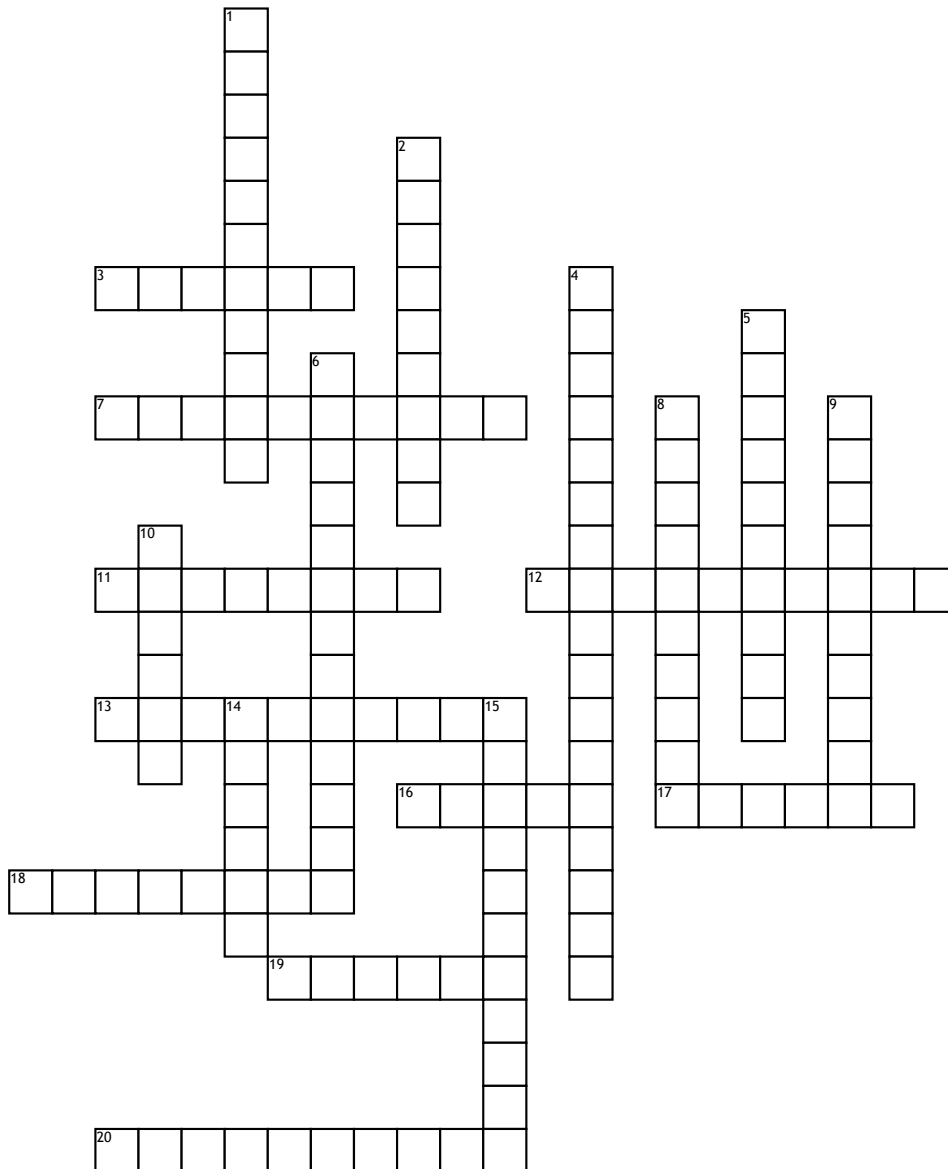


Renaissance Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle
