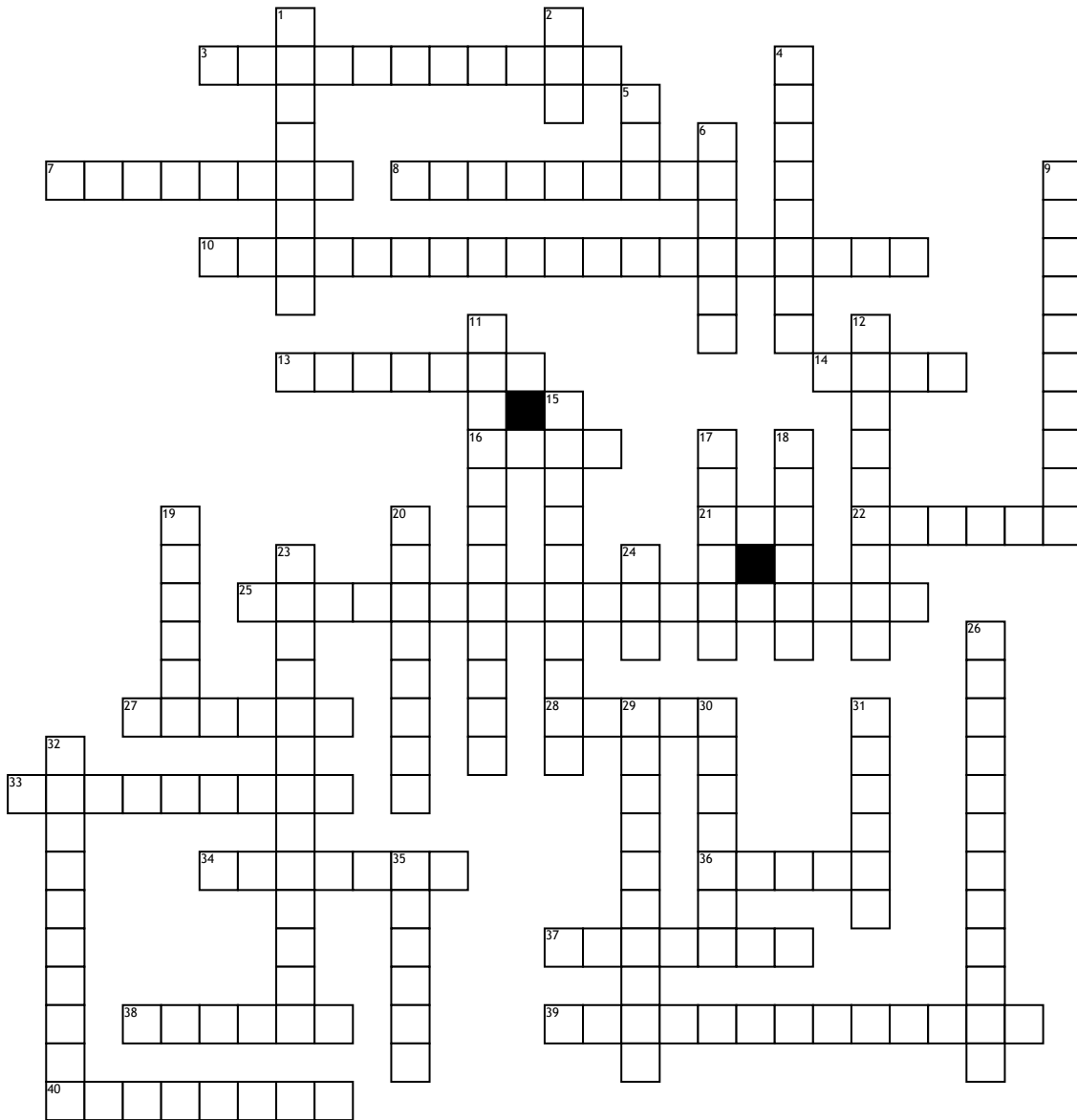


# Reproduction
