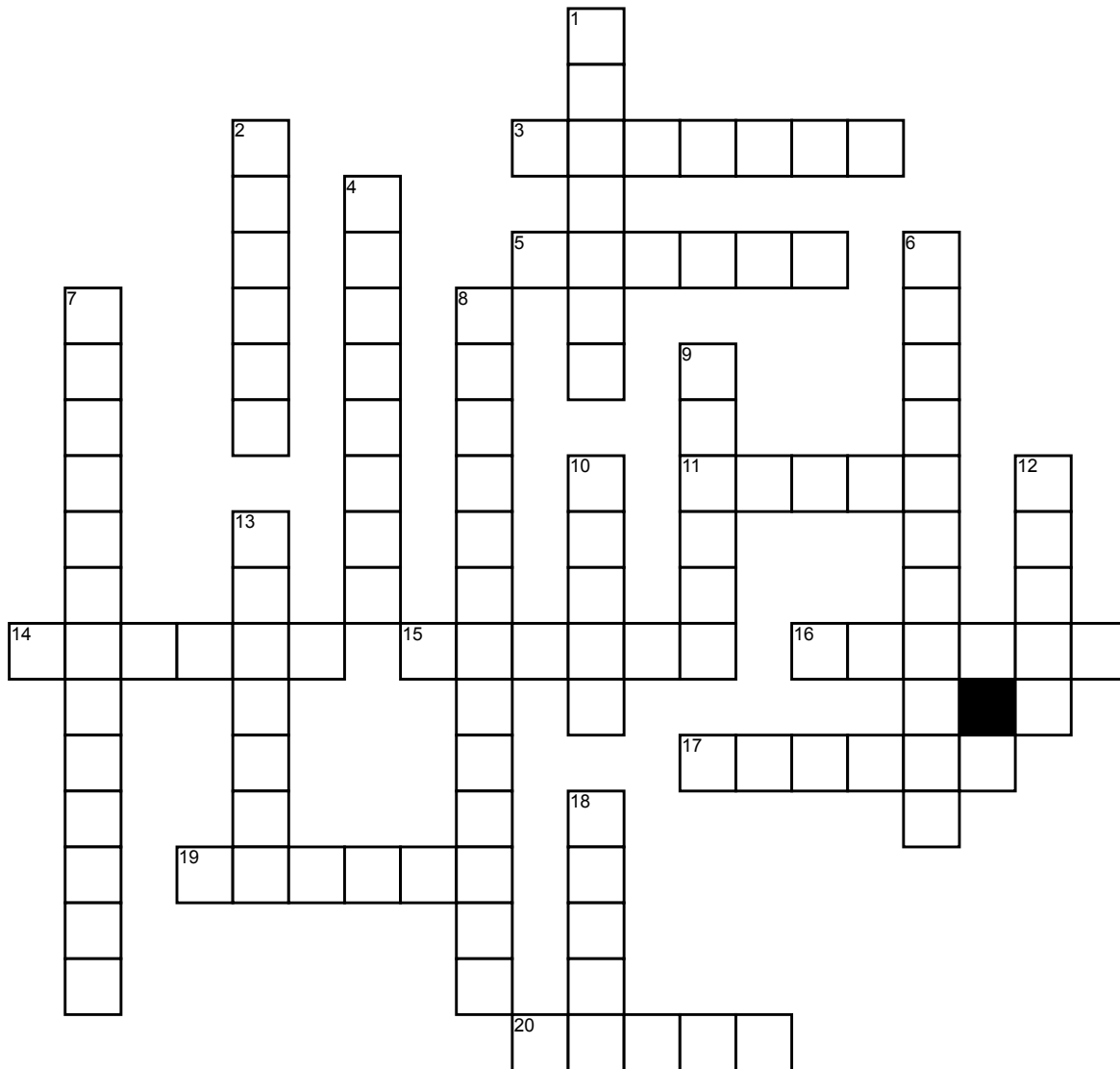


Reproduction and Cells Crossword
