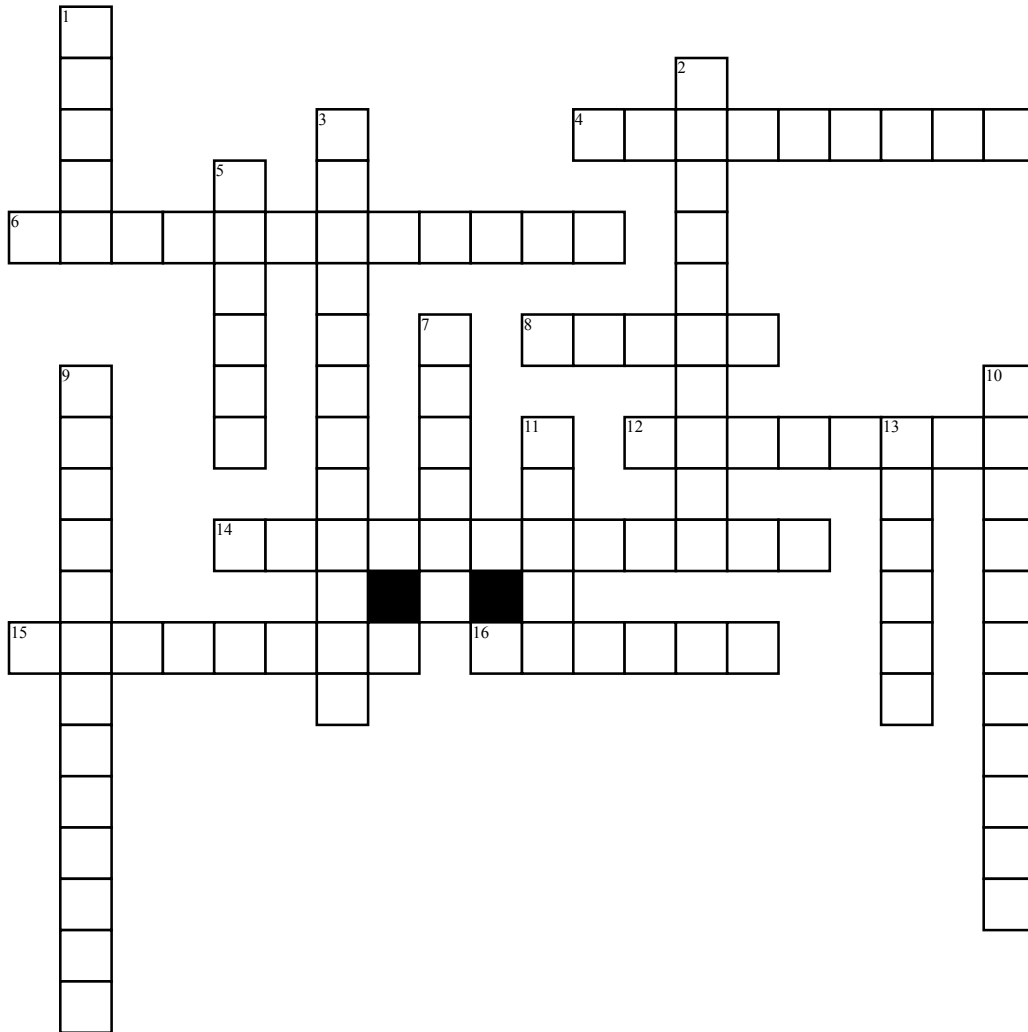


Reproductive Management: Week 5
