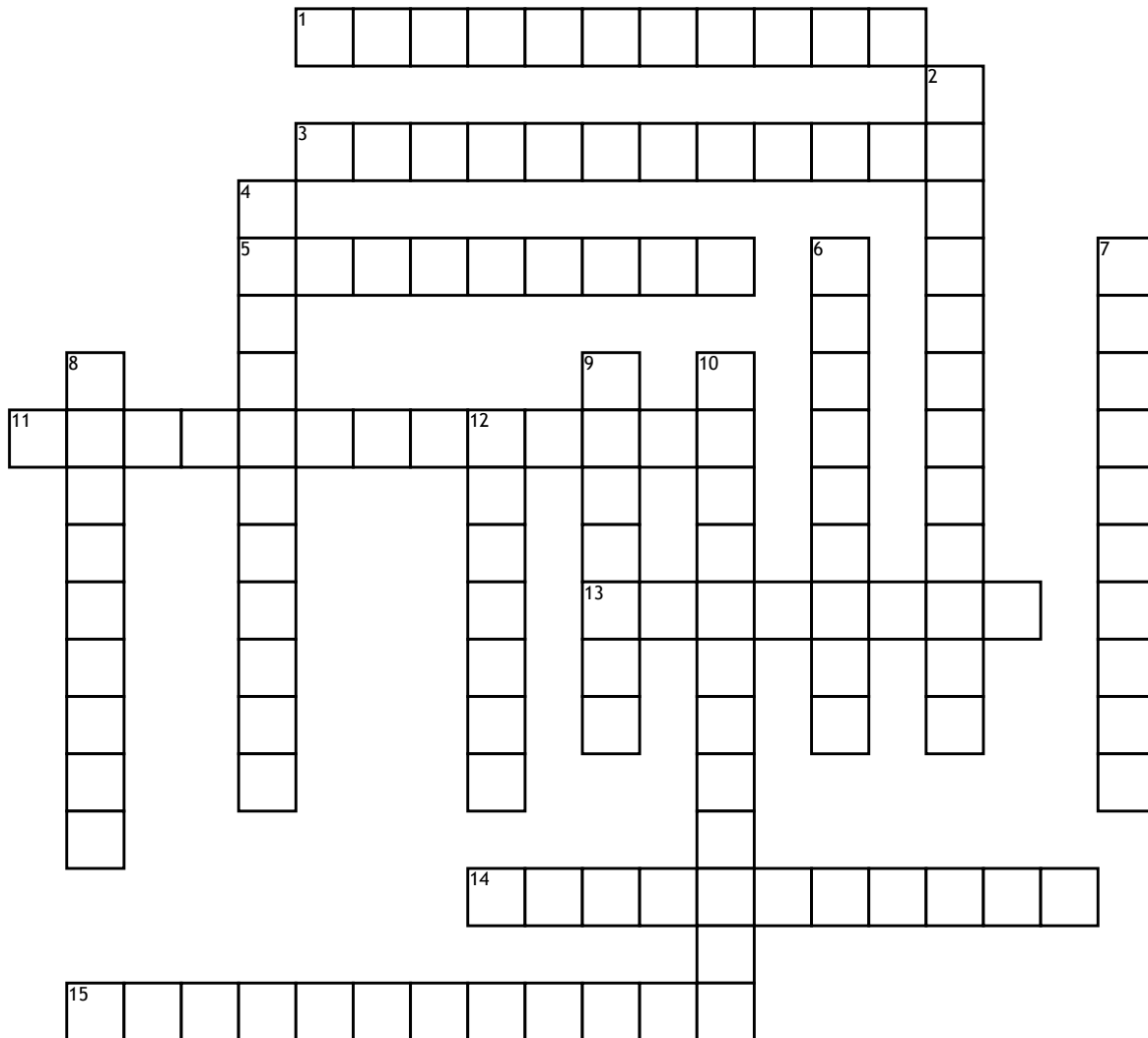


Reproductive Medical Terminology
