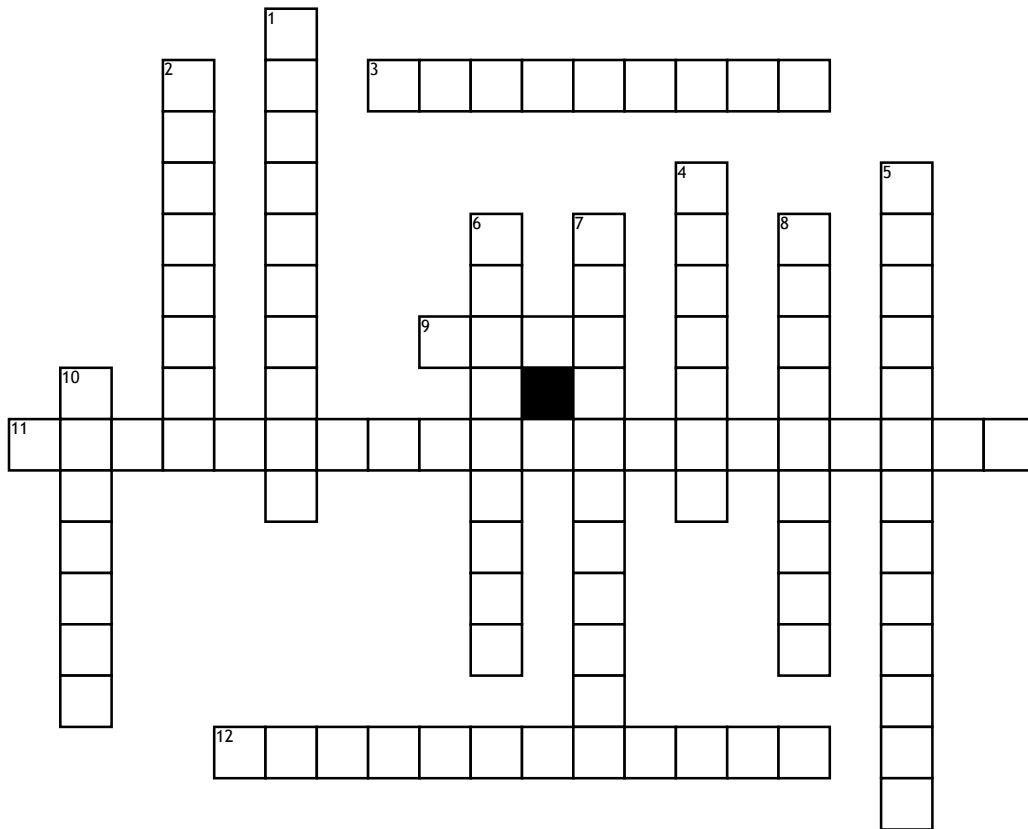


# Respiratory Distress Terms

2. Bluish or grey coloring of skin and nails

5. Used to monitor baby's oxygen levels

6. Heated and humidified high flow oxygen through nasal cannula

7. elevated carbon dioxide

8. Diagnostic procedure used for lungs

10. Method used for the mouth, trachea, and nose as needed
