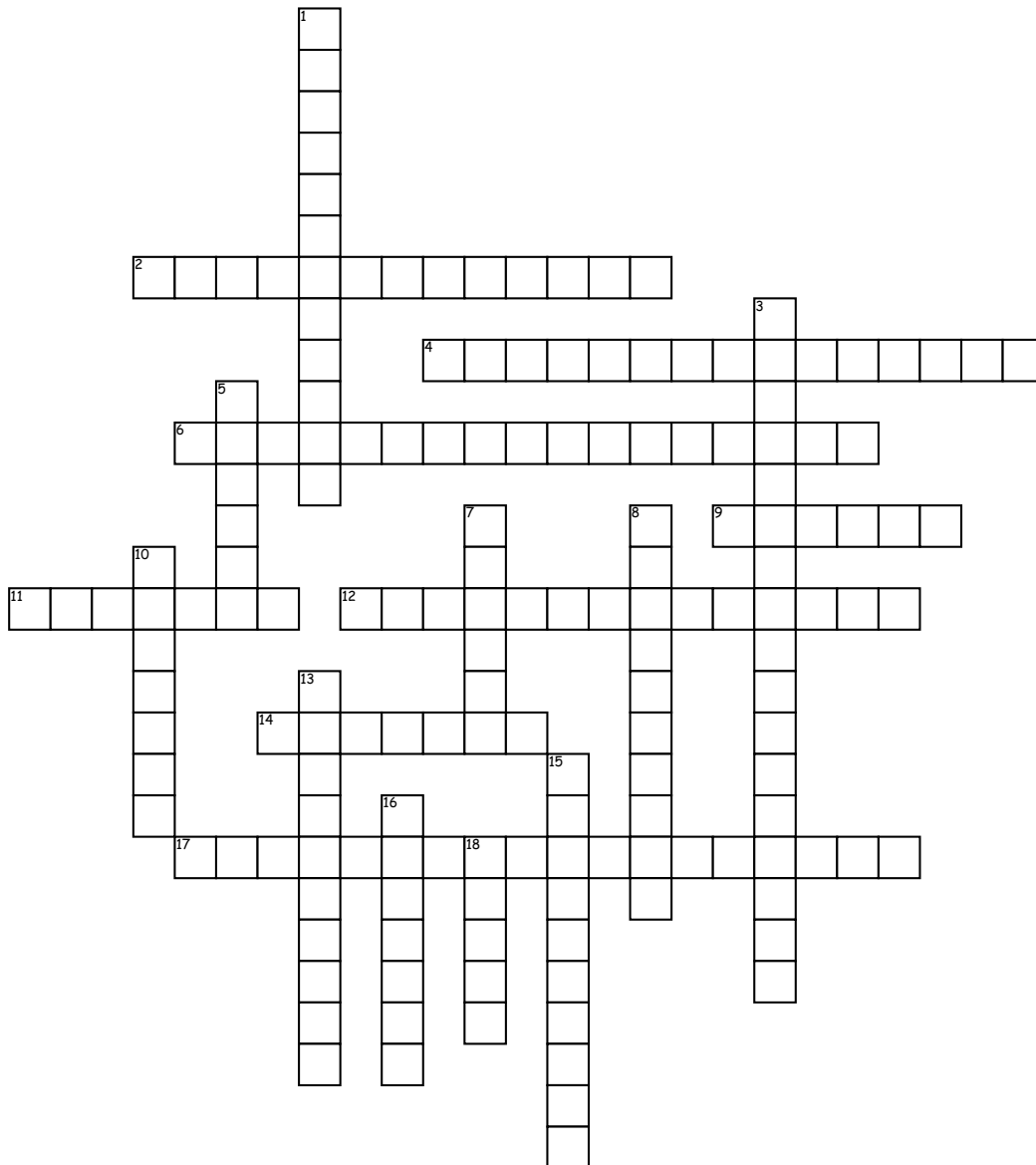

15. decreases surface tension of alveoli
