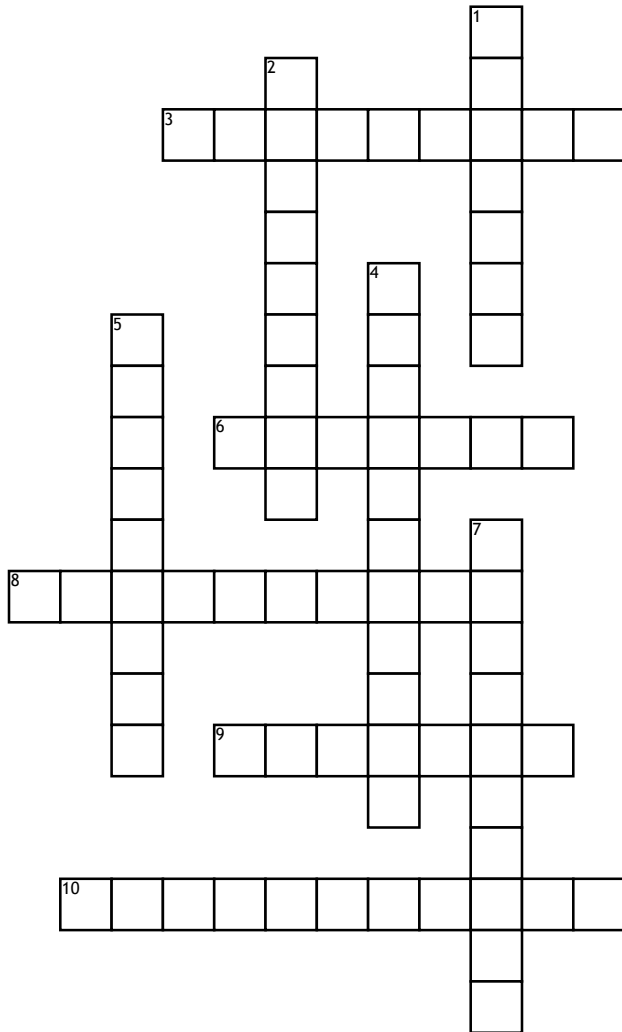


# Respiratory System



## Across

3. A muscle which contracts to increase the volume of the lungs and draw air into the lungs.
6. The main passageways into the lungs. They break down into smaller passageways called bronchioles
8. Pushing air out of the lungs - breathing out.
9. Tiny air sacs that are present at the site of gas exchange.
10. A chemical reaction taking place in all living cells

## Down

1. The windpipe - tube between throat and lungs.
2. A thin blood vessel only one blood cell wide found at the site of gas exchange
4. The passageways by which air passes through to reach the alveoli.
5. The mechanical movement of air in and out of the lungs.
7. Drawing air into the lungs - breathing in.
