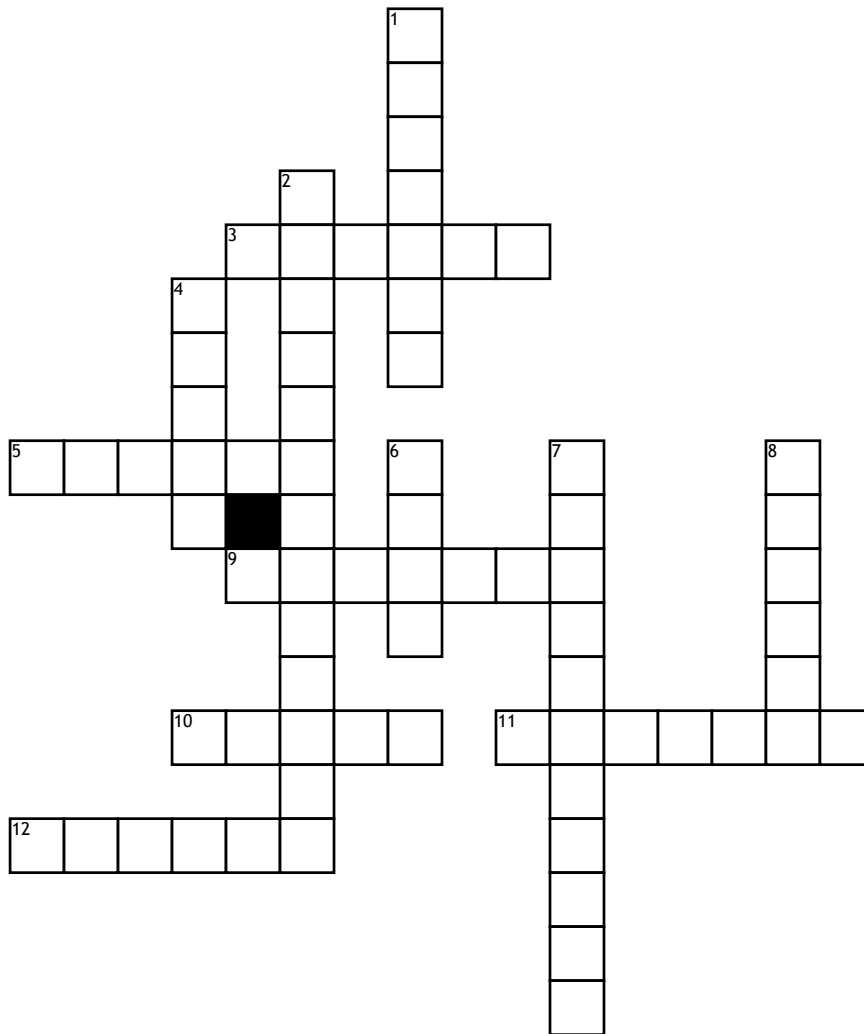


# Respiratory System
