

Respiratory System

1. Air sac in the lung
 2. Voice box; Contains the vocal cords
 3. Exchange of air in the lung capillaries
 4. Exchange of gases in the cells
 5. Thin hairs attached to the mucous membrane epithelium lining the respiratory tract
 6. Throat; including the nasopharynx, oropharynx, and laryngopharynx
 7. Muscle separating the chest and abdomen; Contracts to pull air into the lungs; Relaxes to push air out of the lungs
 8. Process of moving air into and out of the lungs
 9. Branch of the trachea (windpipe) that is a passageway into the lung
 10. Carry oxygen away from the lungs to all parts of the body and carbon dioxide back to the lungs for exhalation
