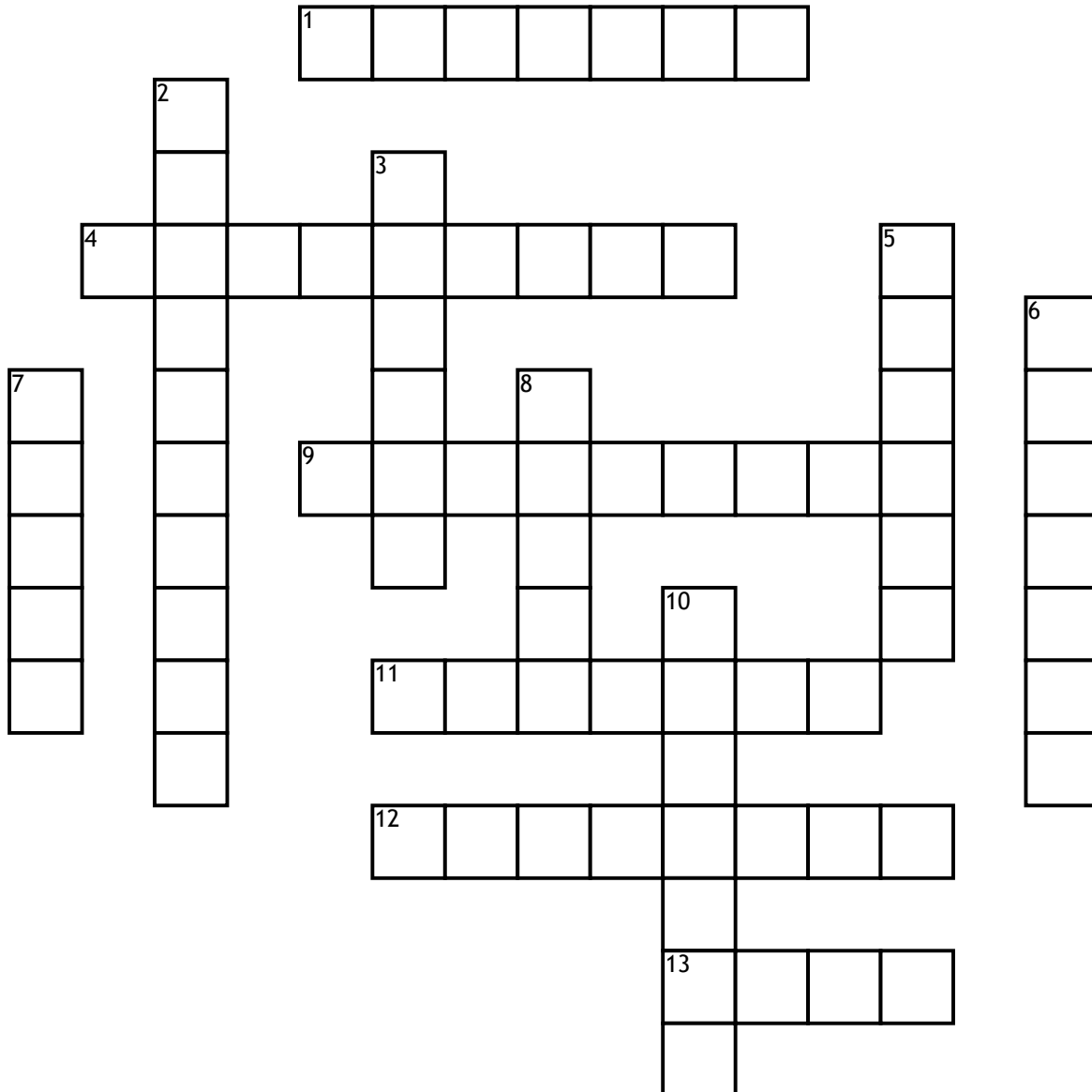


Respiratory System



Across

1. The air cells in the lungs
4. Dome shaped muscular structure when relaxed
9. The smallest blood vessel
11. Connects the pharynx and larynx to the lungs
12. Blood vessels that carry blood away from the heart
13. Entrance to the respiratory system

Down

2. A thin, triangular plate of cartilage that covers the entrance to the trachea during swallowing, so that food and drink do not get into the lungs
3. The part of the body passing from the mouth to the stomach or the lungs,
5. The upper part of the respiratory tract between the pharynx and the trachea; it's lined with cartilage and contains the vocal chords

6. The two branches of the trachea, leading directly to the lungs
7. Moistens the air we breathe
8. Very small, hair-like projections found on certain cells
10. A common passage for food and air
