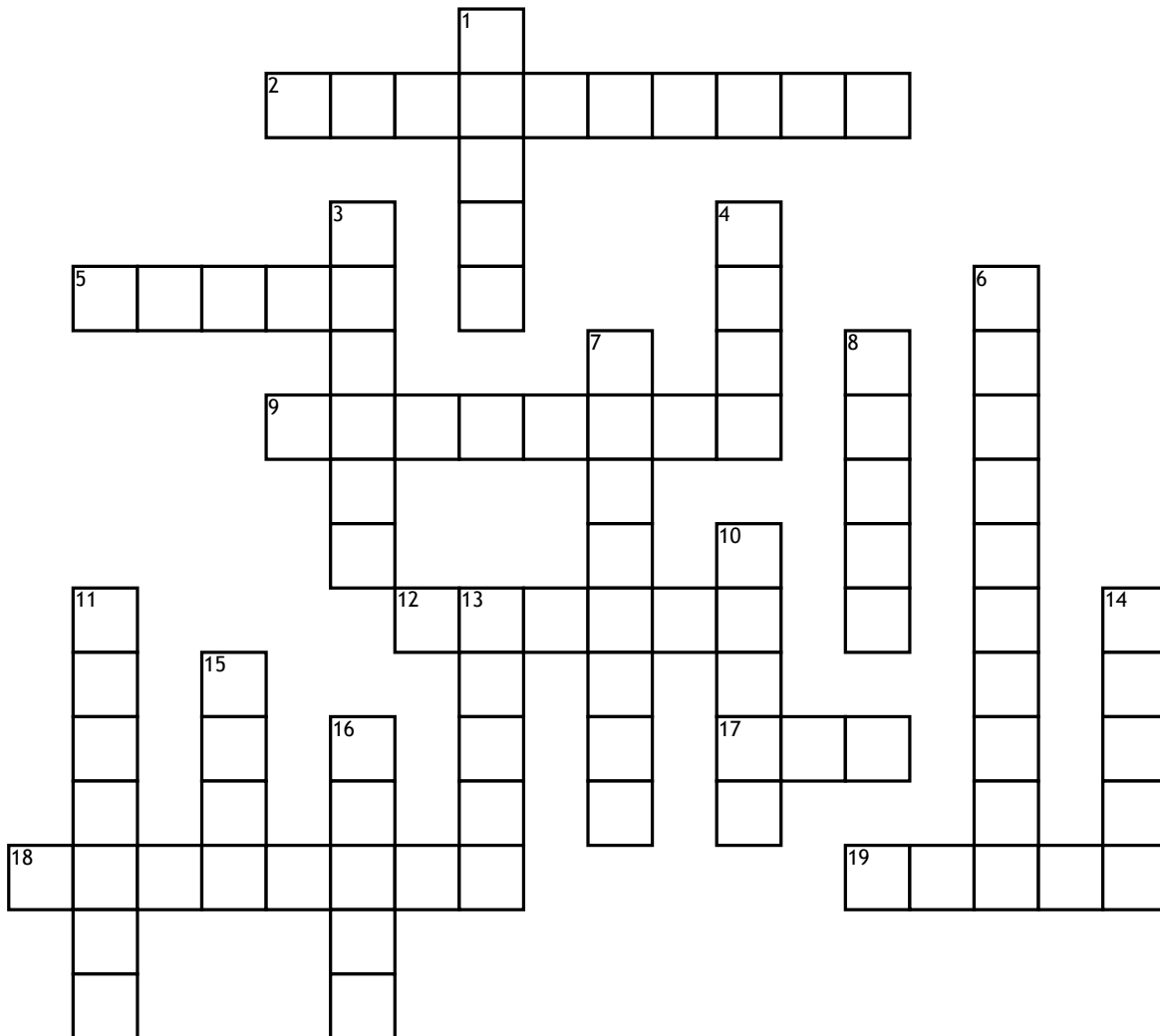


Riddle Crossword
