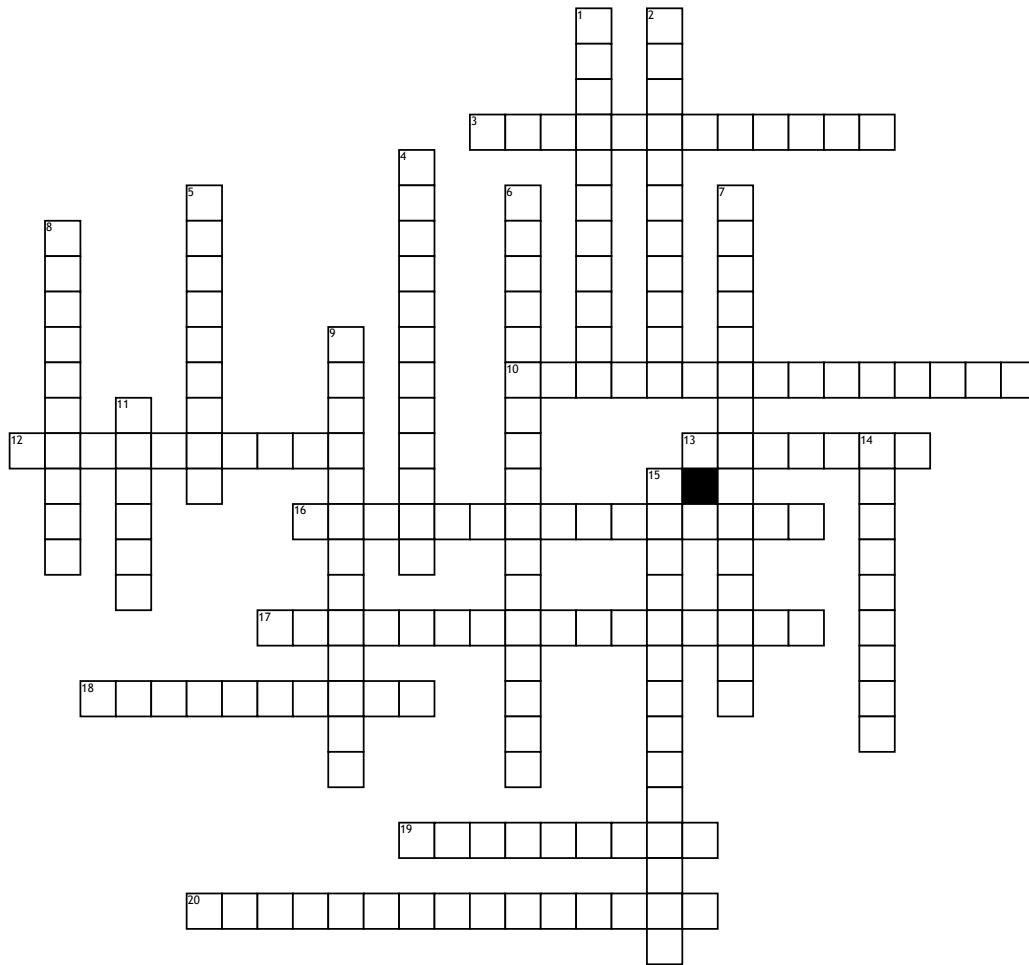


Rise of Totalitarianism
