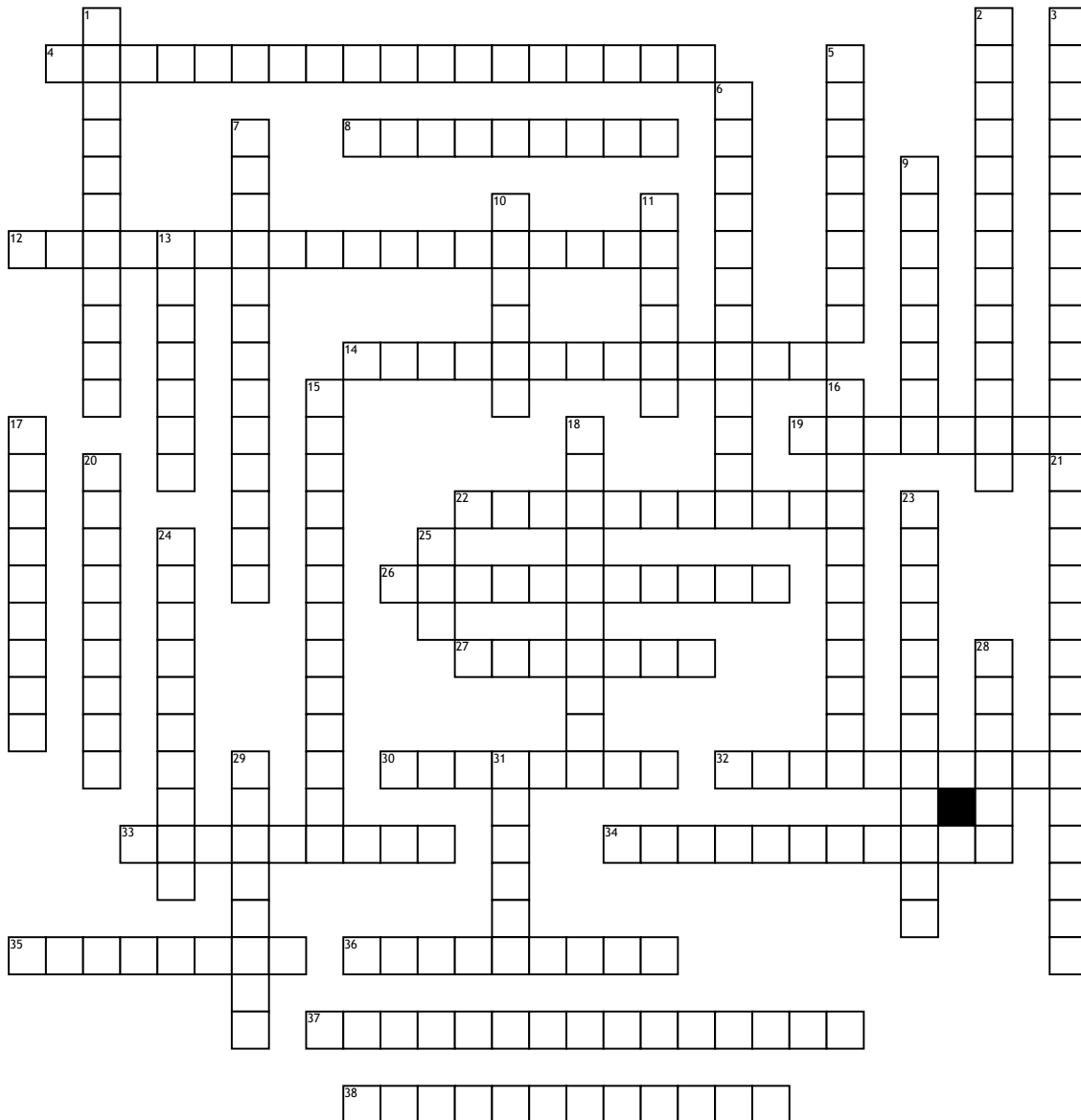


River Valley Civilization (Crossword Puzzle)
