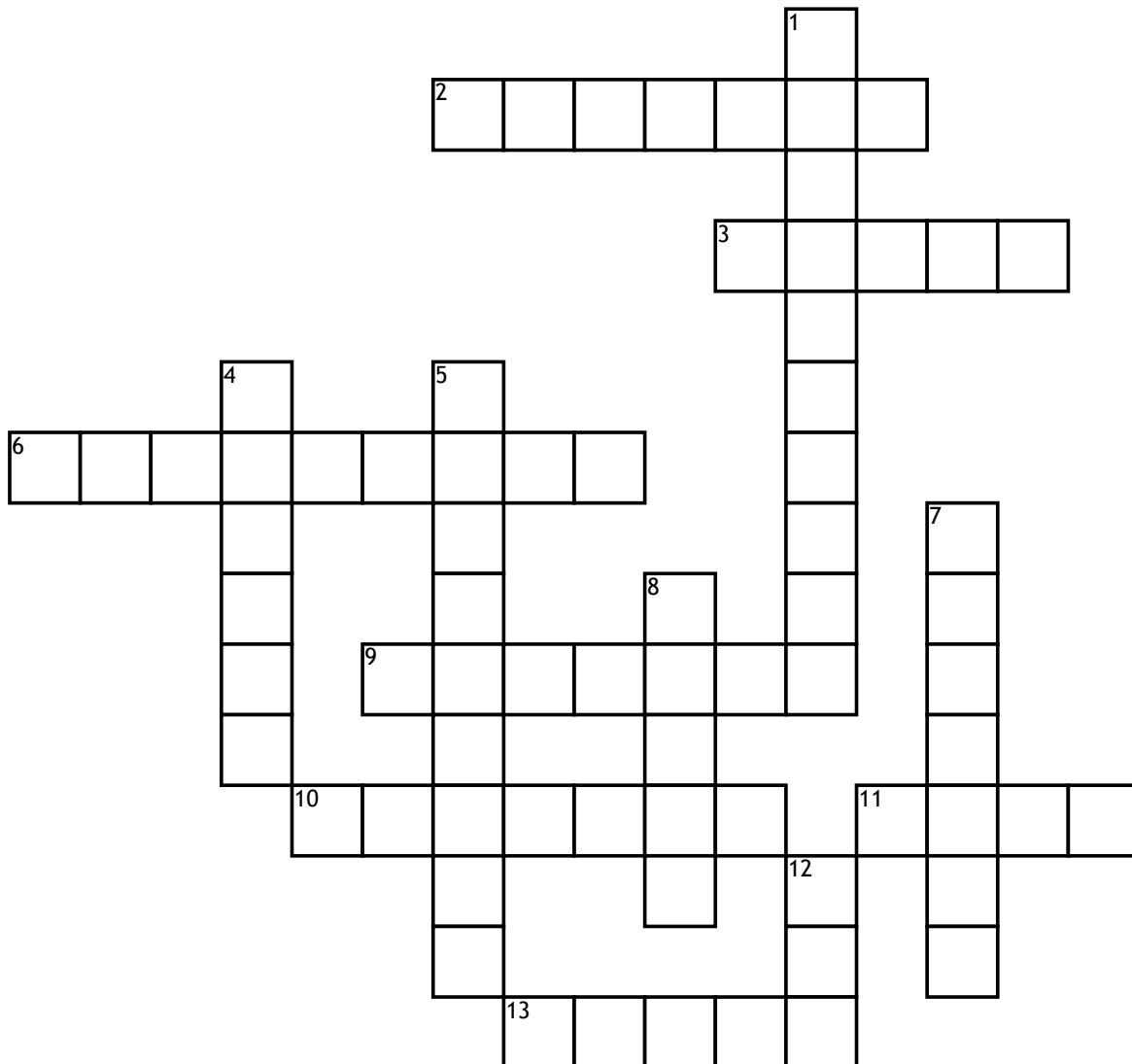


Rivers

2. A bend in the river
 3. The end of the river
 6. A small arc-shaped lake formed when a meander is sealed off by deposition
 9. The wearing away, in this case by water and rocks constantly rubbing
 10. A groove in the land that a river flows along

11. The ground at the side of a river
 13. When a river has too much water in its channel

Down

1. A river lays down or drops the sediment or material that it is carrying such as sand, mud, and small stones or sticks
 4. The start of a river

5. A place where the river course is interrupted by a tall step
 7. Occurs near or at the mouth of a river, where the tide meets the current and the fresh and salt waters mix
 8. A naturally winding watercourse
 12. The ground at the bottom of the river
