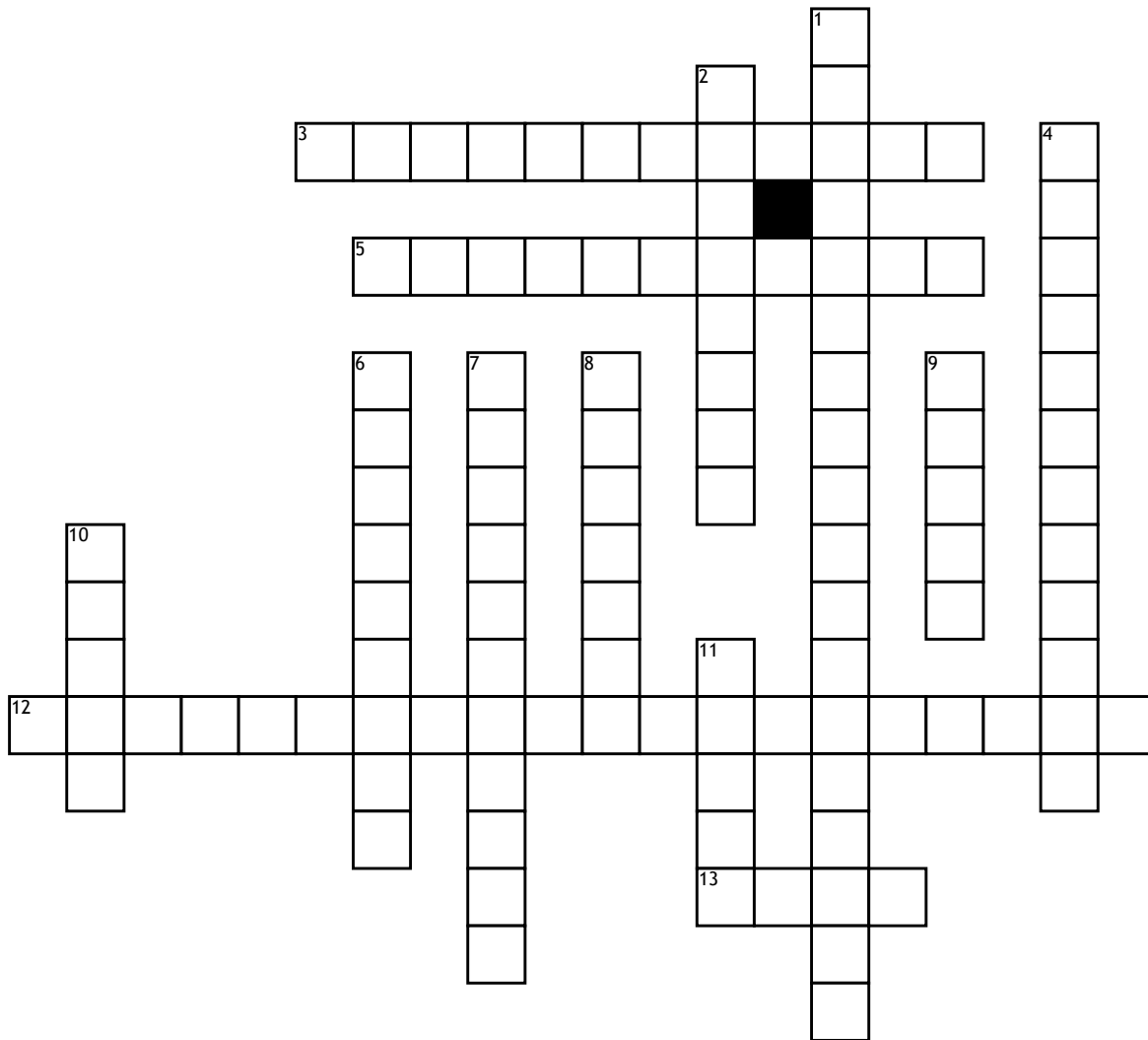


# Rocks and Soil Vocab 17-29



## Across

3. When rocks, regolith, and soil move downwards due to gravity  
 5. A vertical cut of soil showing its succession of horizons and main material  
 12. When rocks are broken down into smaller fragments  
 13. Part of the regolith that has mineral and organic matter, as well as water and air

## Down

1. When the inside of a mineral changes due to adding or taking away an element  
 2. A layer of rock and mineral fragments that cover almost all of Earth's surface  
 4. When rocks are broken due to the expansion of ice within cracks in the rock  
 6. When a mass of rocks moves rapidly down a slope

7. A type of weathering where pressure is reduced, allowing rocks to break off in slabs  
 8. Soil and rock fragments containing lots of water moving rapidly down a slope  
 9. When a mass of rock or unconsolidated material moves as a unit along a curved surface  
 10. The slow downhill movement of soil and regolith  
 11. When broken rock pieces accumulate at the bottom of cliffs
