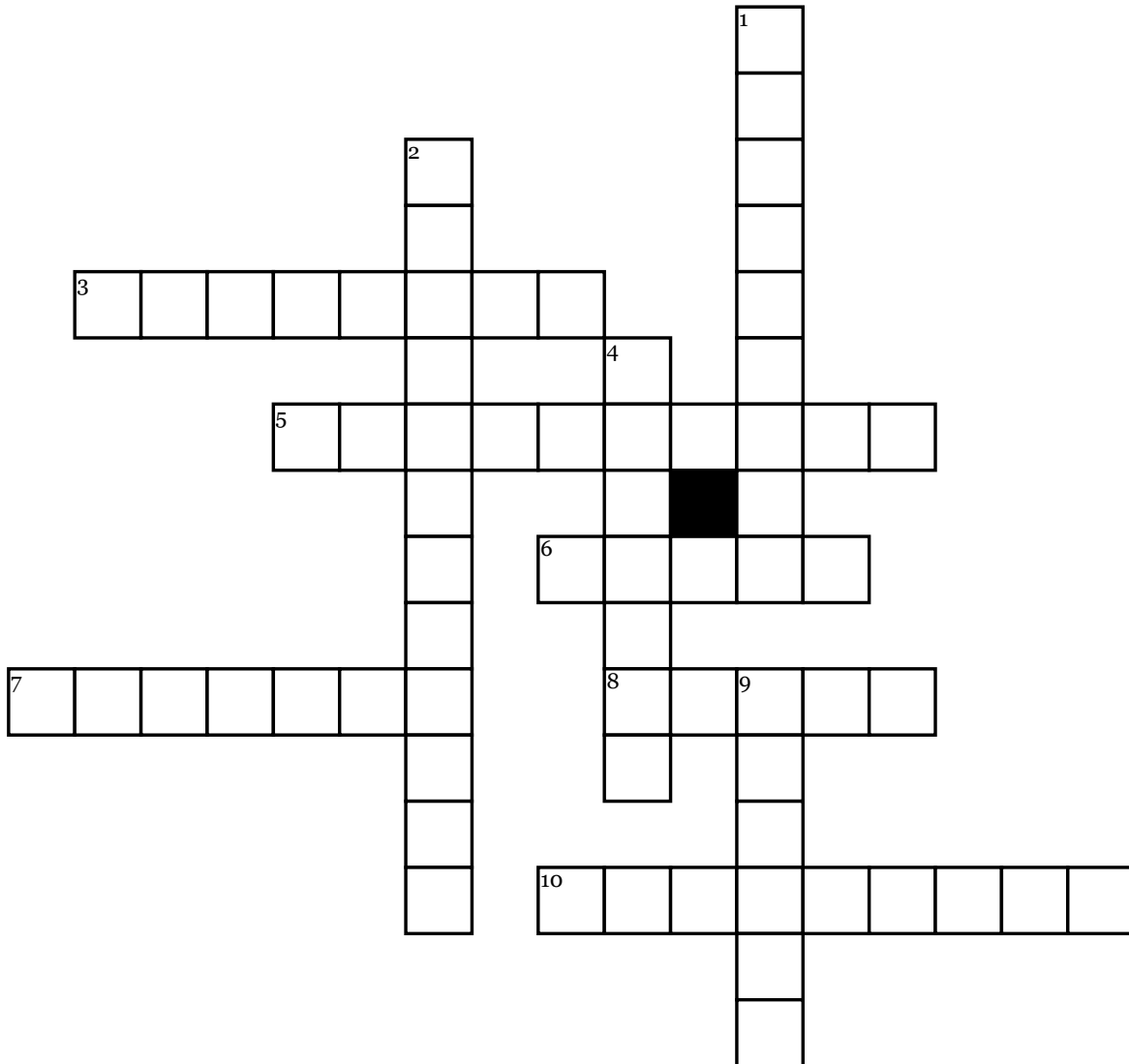


# Rocks not from Earth
