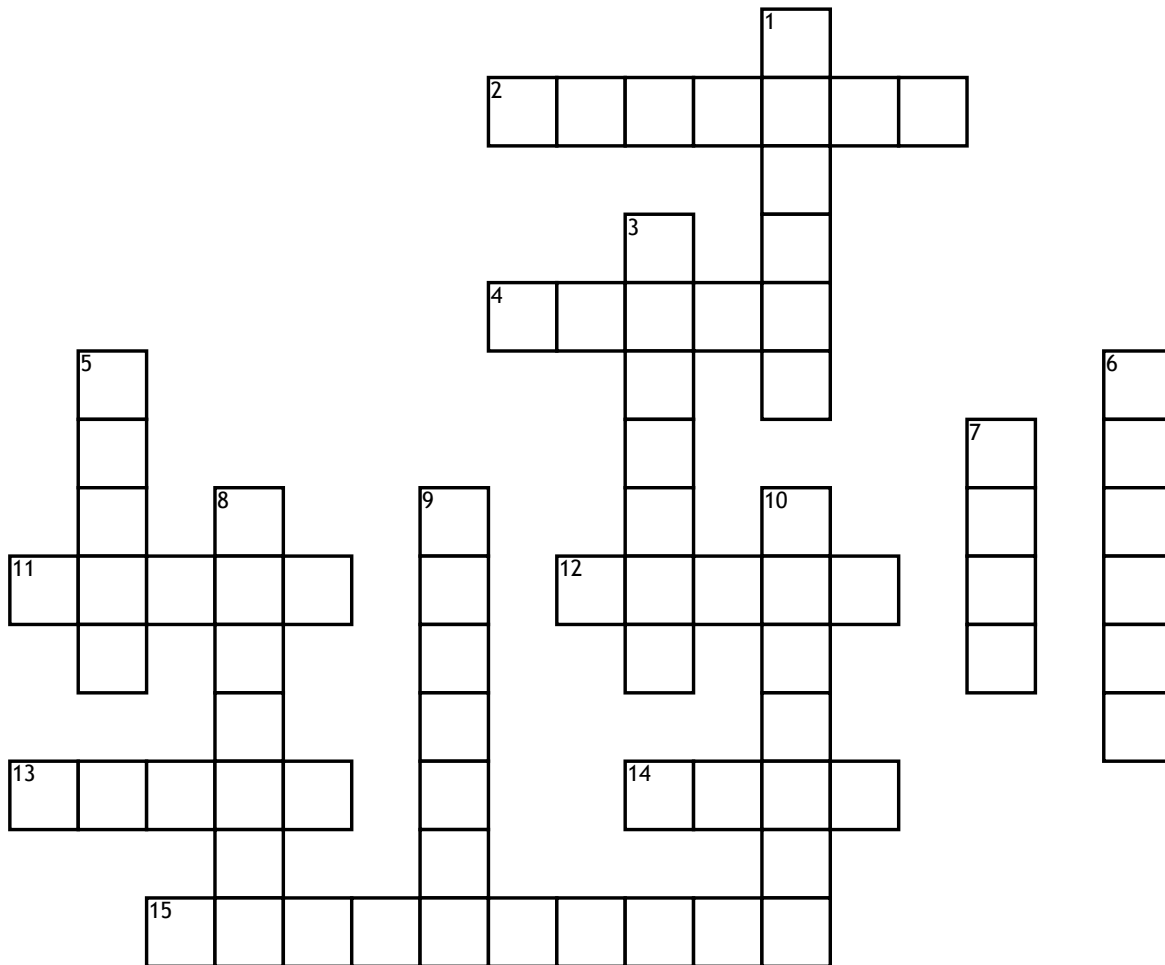


Roman Gods and Goddesses

13. god of wealth and ruler of the under world (symbols include the bident and daffodil)

14. god of war, courage, and civil order (symbols include the helmet, spear, vulture, and snake)

15. goddess of spring and ruler of the underworld (symbols include the pomegranate, grain, and torch)

1. god of volcanoes and mulciber (symbols include the smiths-hammer, fire, and axe)
3. god of grapes, winemaking, and festivities (symbols include the pine tree, thrysos, and grapes)
5. goddess of agriculture and grain (symbols include the may tree, torch, and grain)

6. god of prophecy, music, sun&light, and healing (symbols include the bow and arrow, lyre, and crow/raven)

7. goddess protector of women (symbols include the scepter, goose, and peacock)

8. god of gods and men (symbols include the oak tree, eagle, and lightning)

9. god of the sea, earthquakes, and horses (symbols include the trident, horse, and wild celery)

10. goddess of wisdom, commerce, and handicrafts (symbols include the helmet, owl, and aegis)
