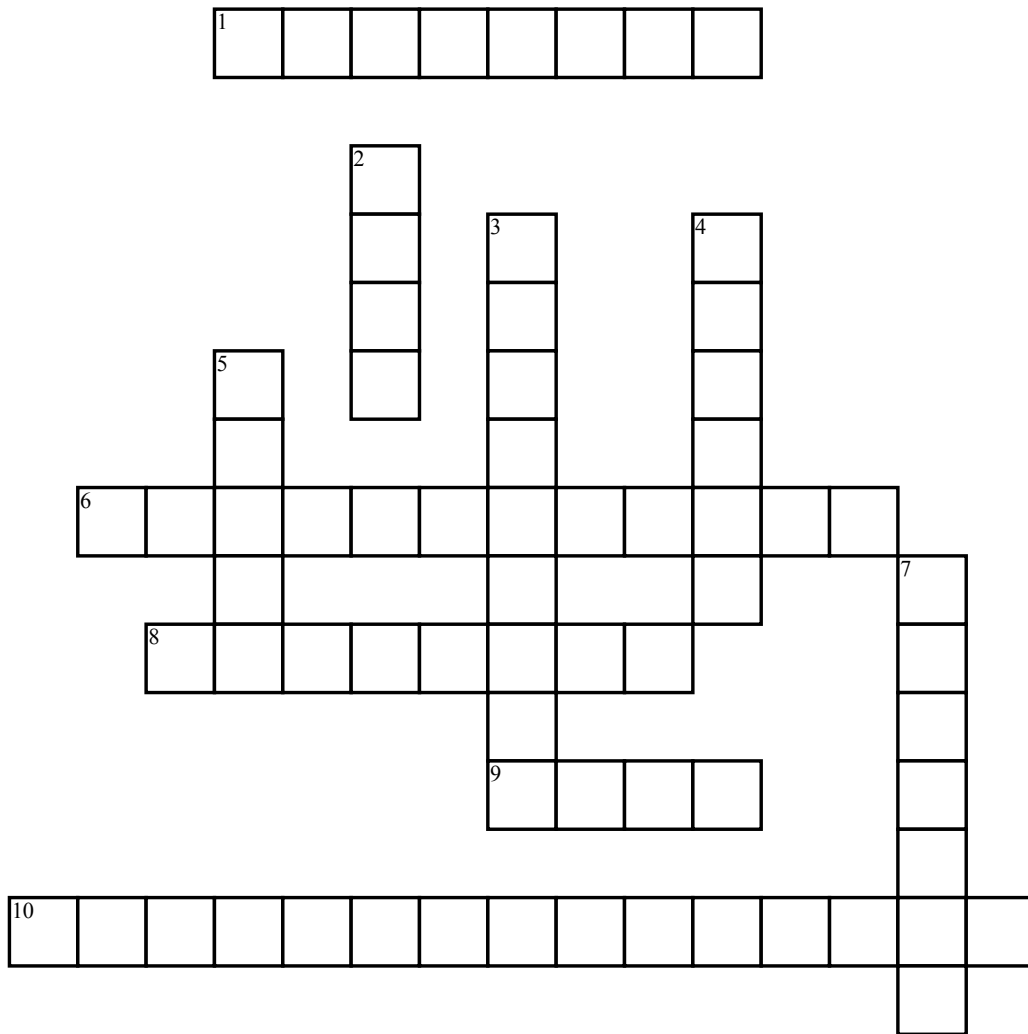


# Roman Republic
