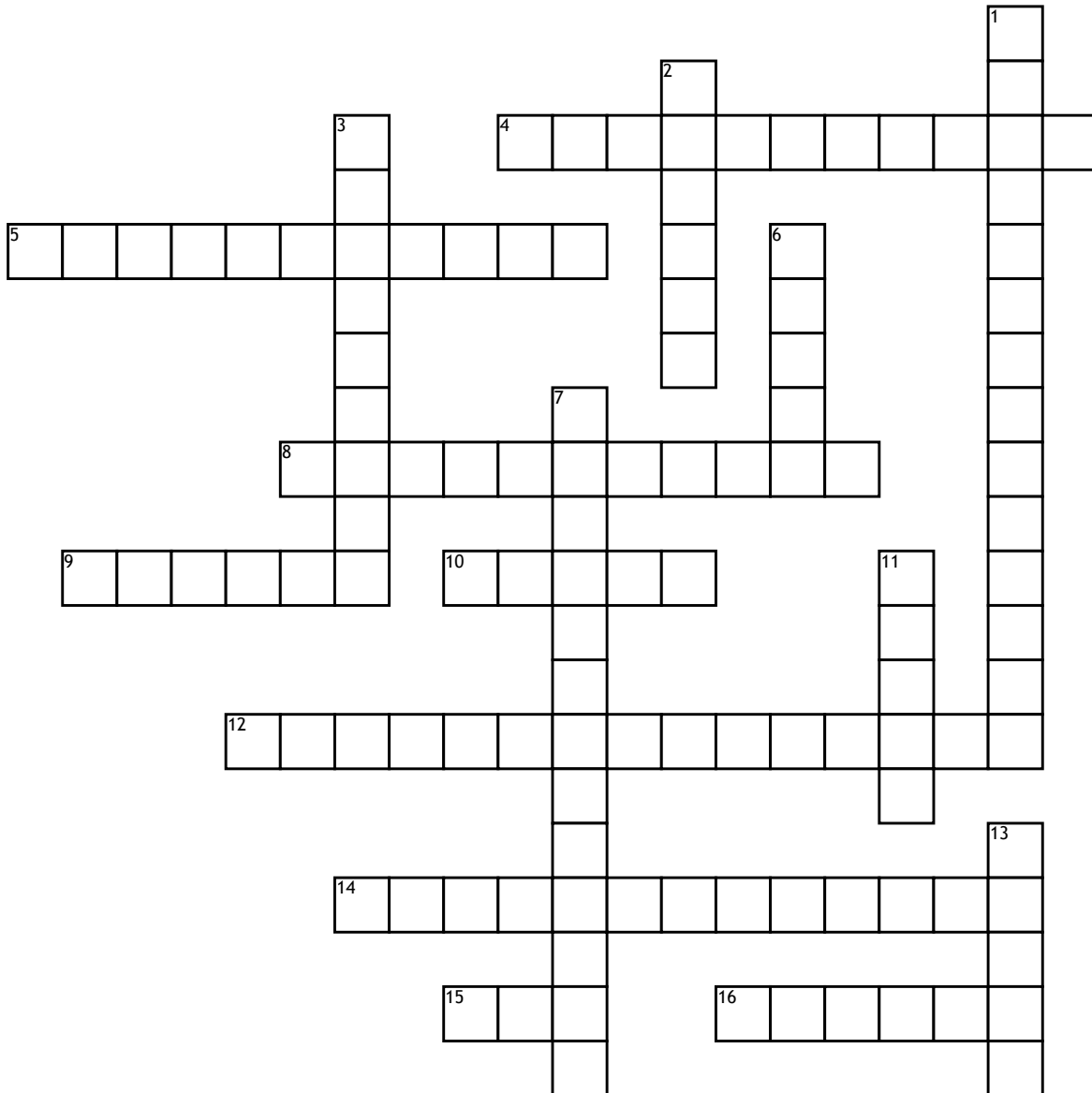


Romeo and Juliet Act 4
