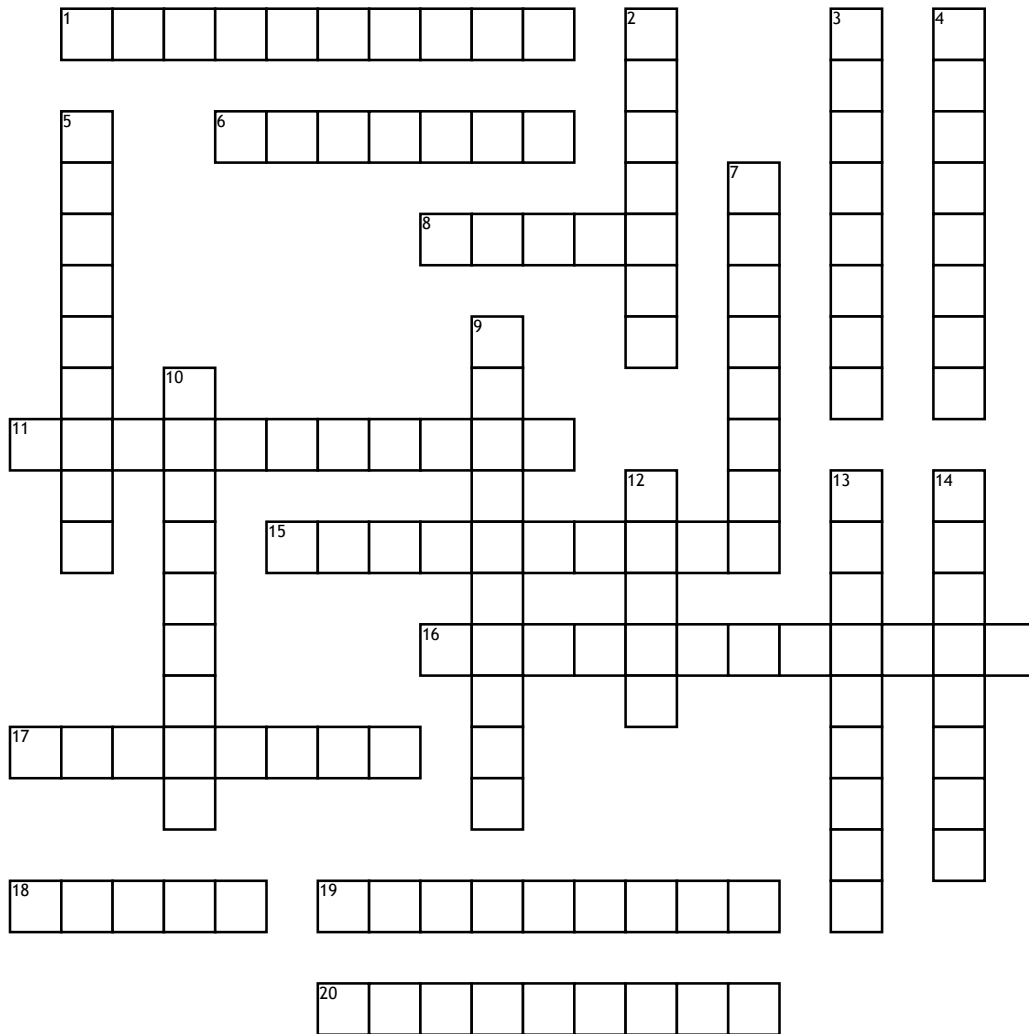


# SAT Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle
