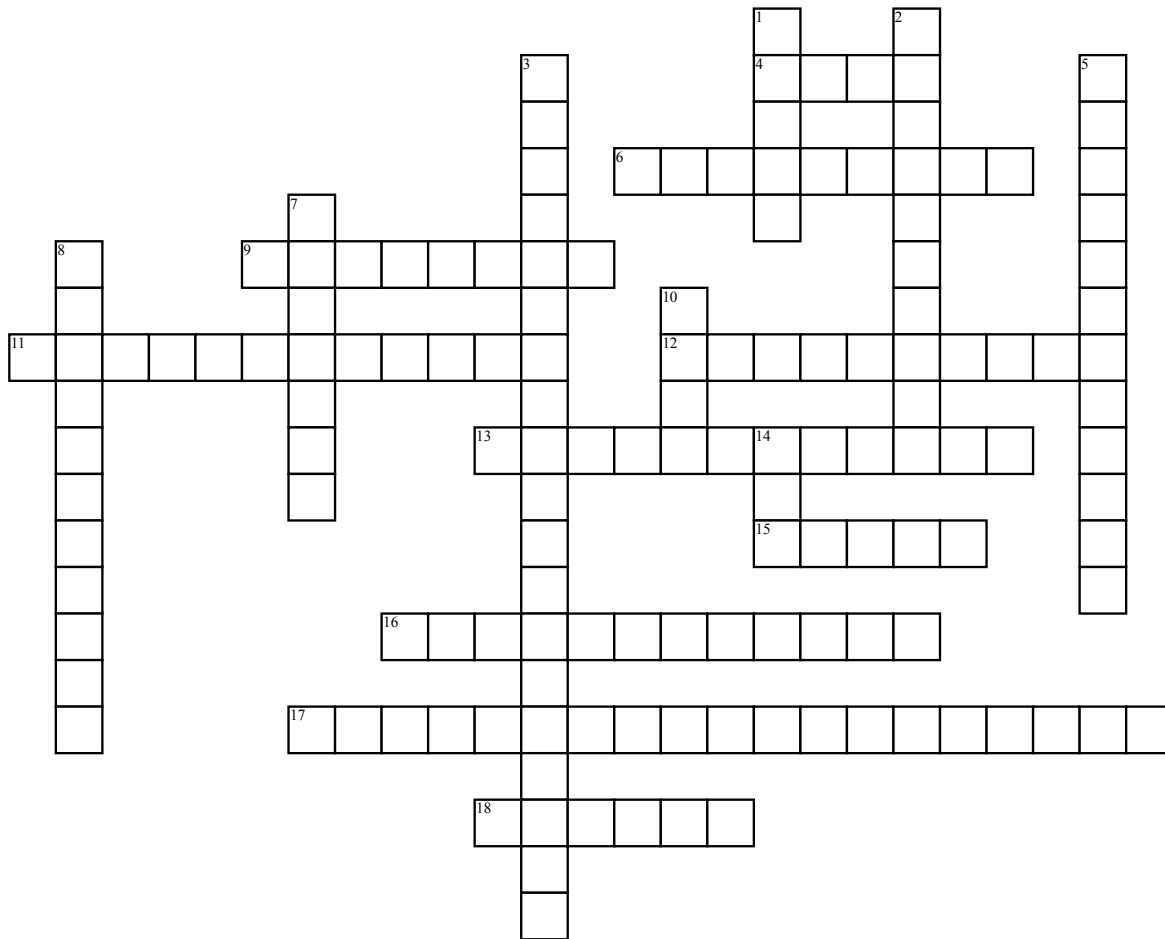


# SSG Board's Crossword Puzzle
