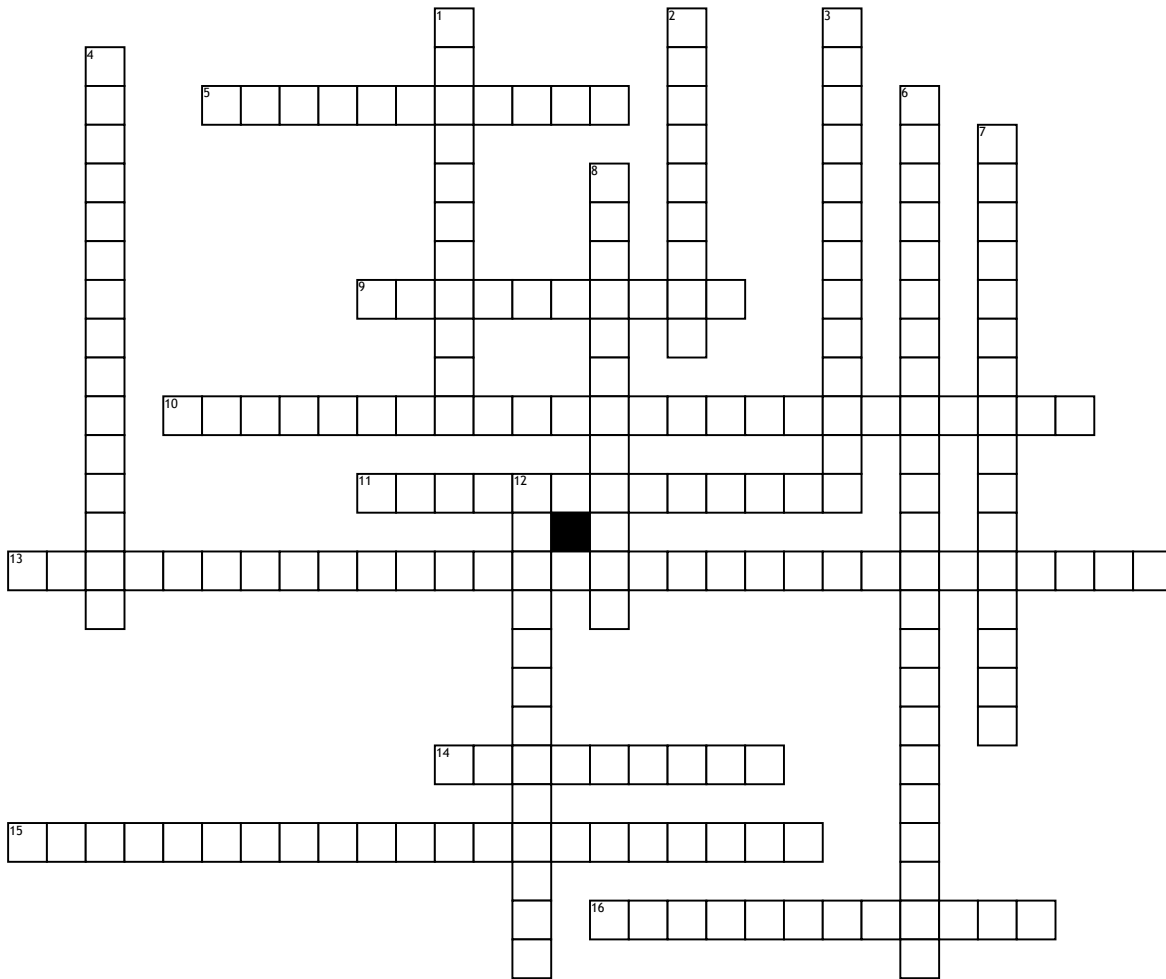


SS Word Puzzle
