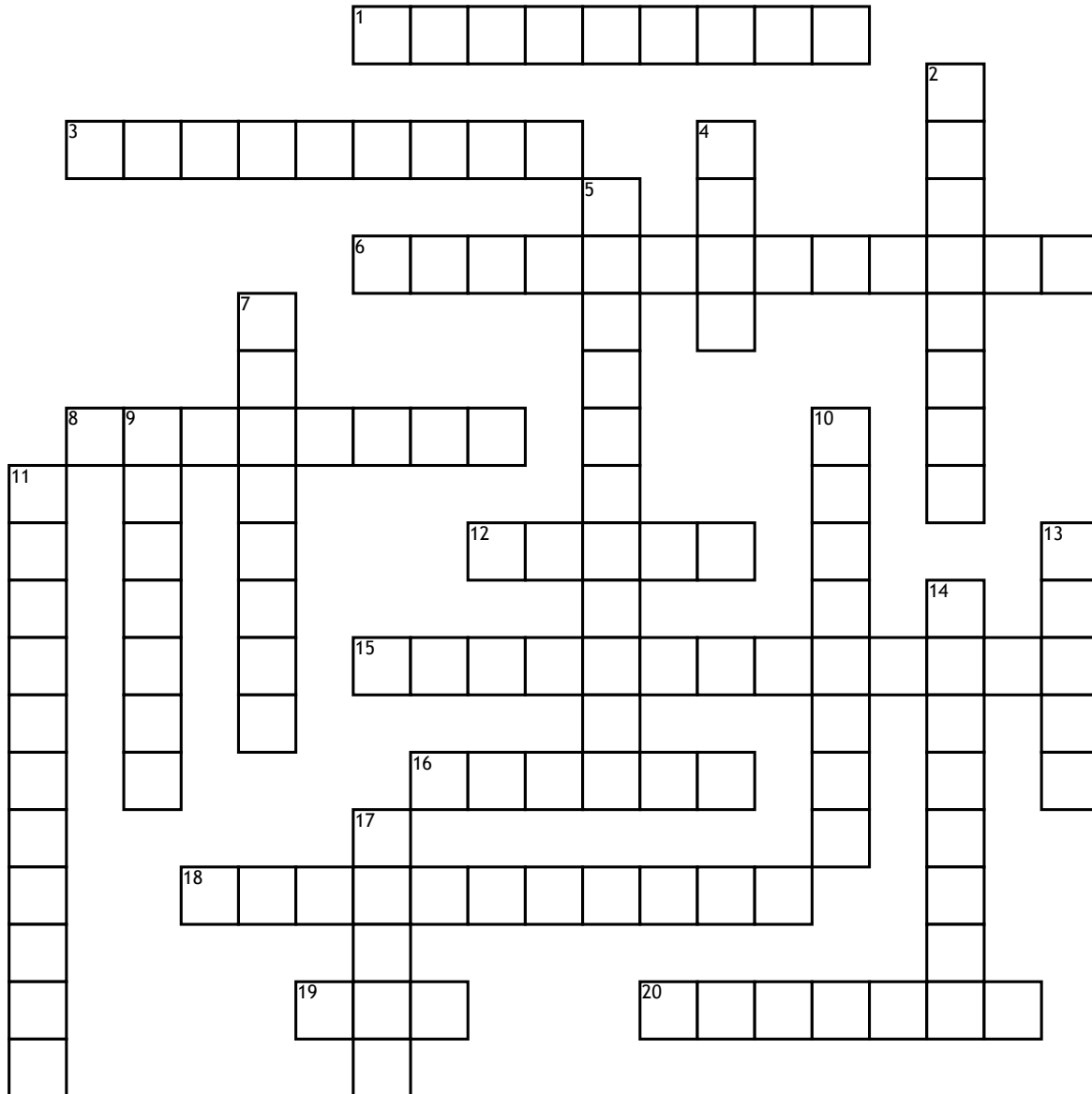


STS CROSSWORD
